Postdoctoral scholars are an integral part of the academic environment at the University of Washington, and contribute readily to the missions of teaching, research, and service. Holding limited appointments, postdoctoral scholars are funded through institutional resources, research grants, and training grants. Postdoctoral titles at the University include Research Associates, Research Associate Trainees, Senior Fellows, and Senior Fellow Trainees, all of which serve on the Seattle, Bothell, or Tacoma campuses.

** Postdoctoral scholars attaining UW professorial titles reflect current professors in the listed school, college, or campus who held a postdoctoral title, regardless of unit, at the UW within the last ten years. (10/31/1996 - 10/31/2006)
