

SUMMARY OF VISION BENEFITS FOR 2007-08

You must meet the applicable deductible before the plan pays vision benefits. The following chart shows your coverage for vision services and supplies:

Deductible	\$10 for exam \$25 for frames/lenses combined \$25 for contacts
Exam	Plan pays 100% after deductible once every 12 months up to \$60
Frames	Plan pays 100% after deductible once every 24 months up to \$70
Basic Lenses	Plan pays 100% after deductible once every 12 months up to:
• Single vision –	\$50
• Bifocal –	\$70
• Trifocal –	\$90
• Lenticular –	\$135
Contacts (instead of lenses and frames*)	Plan pays 100% after deductible once every 12 months up to:
• Necessary –	\$250/pair
• Cosmetic –	\$105/pair

**After the purchase of contacts, lenses aren't covered for another 12 months and frames aren't covered for another 24 months.*

For your contacts to be considered necessary, your provider must get prior approval for one of these conditions:

- Certain conditions of anisometropia
- Following cataract surgery
- Keratoconus
- To correct extreme visual acuity problems that cannot be corrected with spectacle lenses.
