

Examples of Quarterly Tax Deductions for Different Family Scenarios in the 2006 Tax Year *

* These are examples of the most common family scenarios, if you don't see your scenario here, you can use the imputed income chart to determine your quarterly imputed income, and then multiply that amount, by each tax percentage to find what your deduction will be.
