This job title is to be used only during Summer Quarter for ASEs who are not registered but who are employed to do research tasks that would normally be provided by graduate research assistants in GSSA titles covered by the UW/UAW Local 4121 Contract.

Under Article 24 of the UW/UAW ASE Contract, GRSA's must be paid at least the equivalent rates for the positions for which they would qualify if registered. GRSA's may be appointed to higher classification pay rates at the discretion of the departments or hiring units. DEPARTMENTS OR HIRING UNITS THAT HAVE PAID INDIVIDUAL NON-REGISTERED ASEs ABOVE THE EQUIVALENT MINIMUM RATES DURING THE PRIOR SUMMER (2007) SHALL INCREASE THOSE RATES BY 2.5 % EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008.

A graduate student who IS REGISTERED for summer quarter and doing bargaining unit research work must be paid on an FTE basis as a graduate RA, PDRA1 or PDRA2.

PLEASE NOTE: GRSA's should be paid at least the minimum rates corresponding to the rates paid by their academic departments regardless of where they are employed on campus.
