It can be daunting to look for a good place to live. Here are 10 important things to look for when you are looking at a rental unit:

Rental Property Self Inspection Checklist

- Locks on front doors and individual rooms if shared housing
- Functioning windows
- No overgrown vegetation which can make a house a prime target for burglaries
- Ceiling without signs of holes, leaks, cracks or dents
- No mold inside doorframes and under sinks
- Functioning smoke and carbon monoxide alarms
- Functioning electrical outlets
- Functioning and clean vents
- Good plumbing without leaks or drips
- Look for other minor aesthetic concerns like stains on carpet, chipped paint or nails in walls
