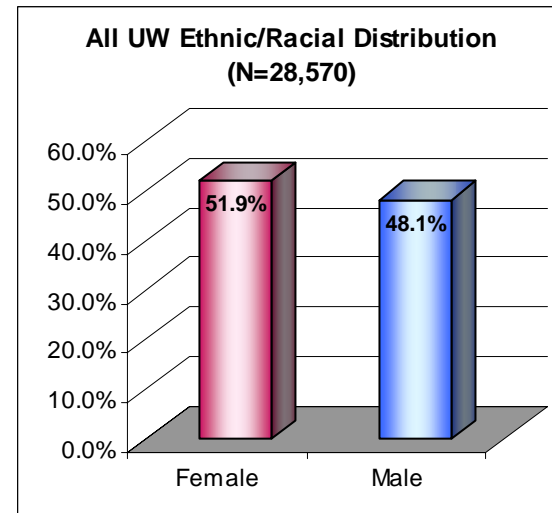
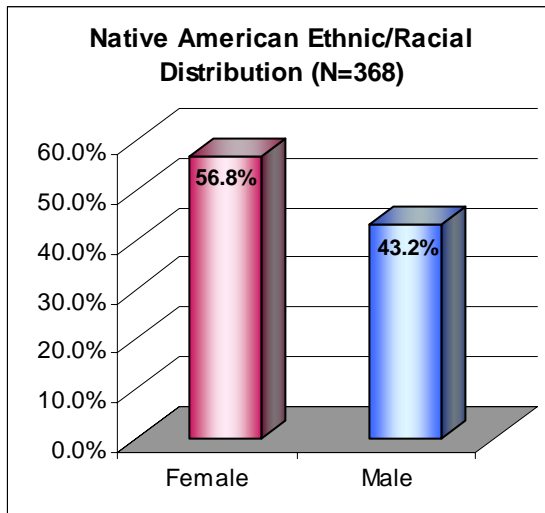
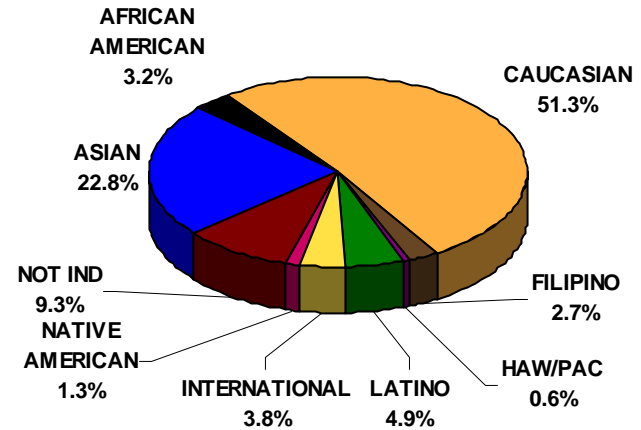

ETHNIC/RACIAL DISTRIBUTION (N = 28,570)



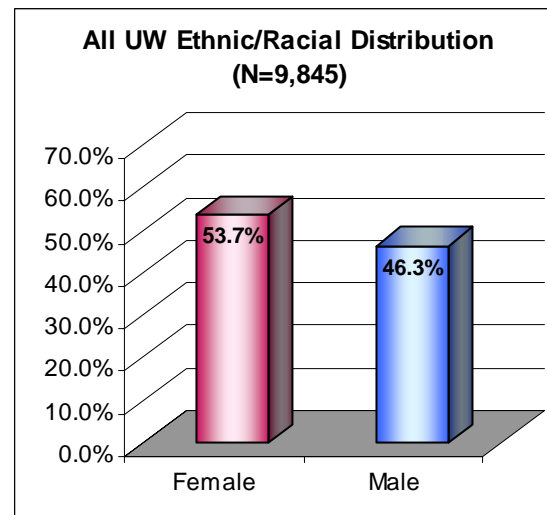
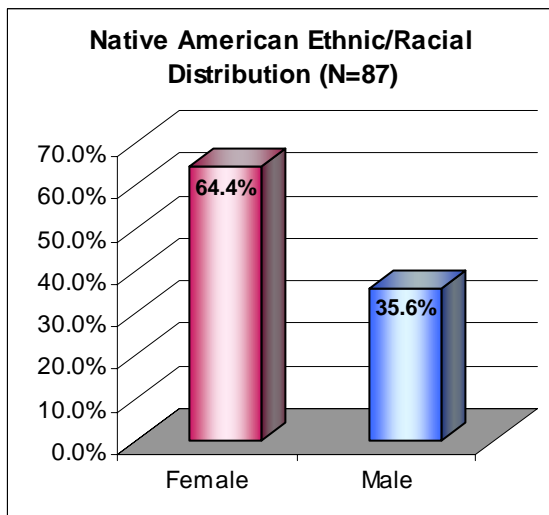
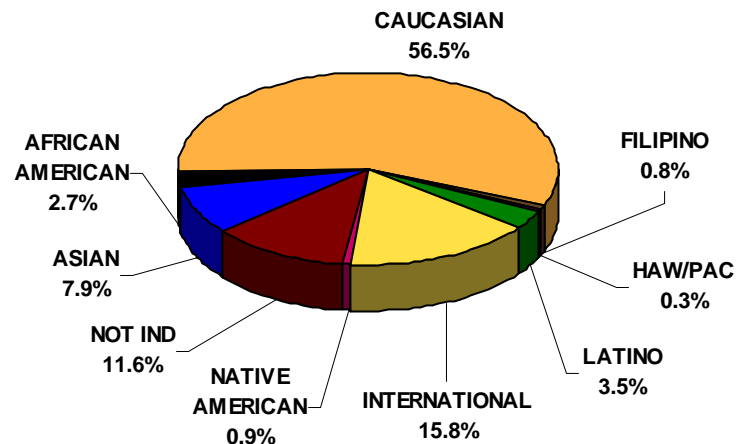

ETHNIC/RACIAL DISTRIBUTION (N = 9,845)



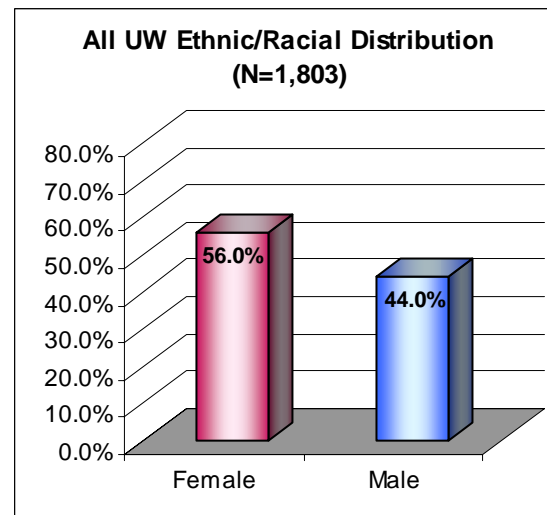
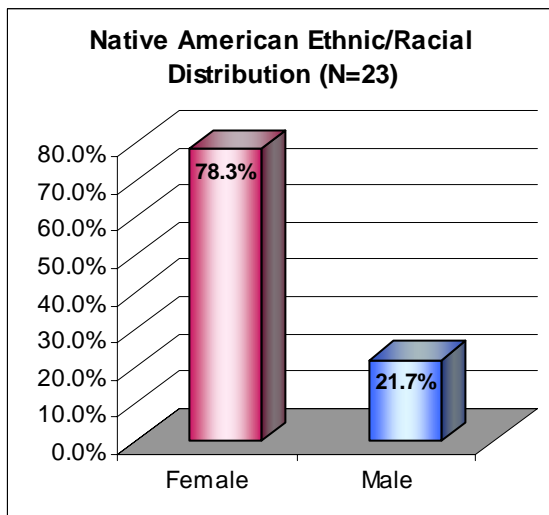
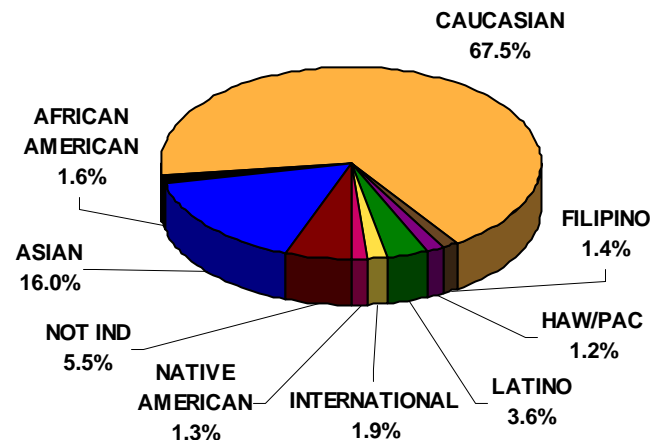

ETHNIC/RACIAL DISTRIBUTION (N = 1,803)



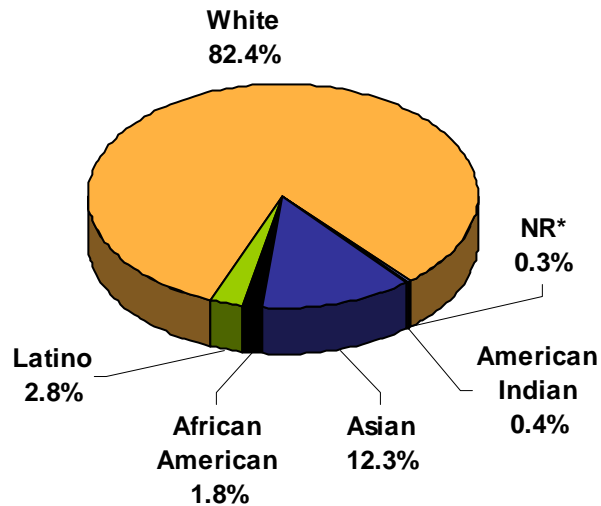

GENDER DISTRIBUTION

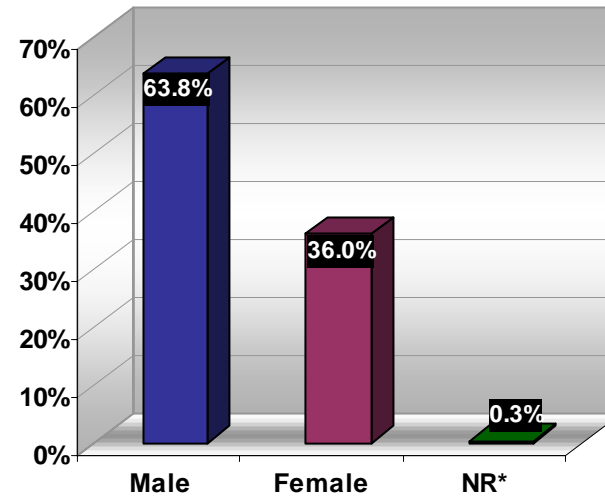

UW STAFF WORKFORCE PROFILE

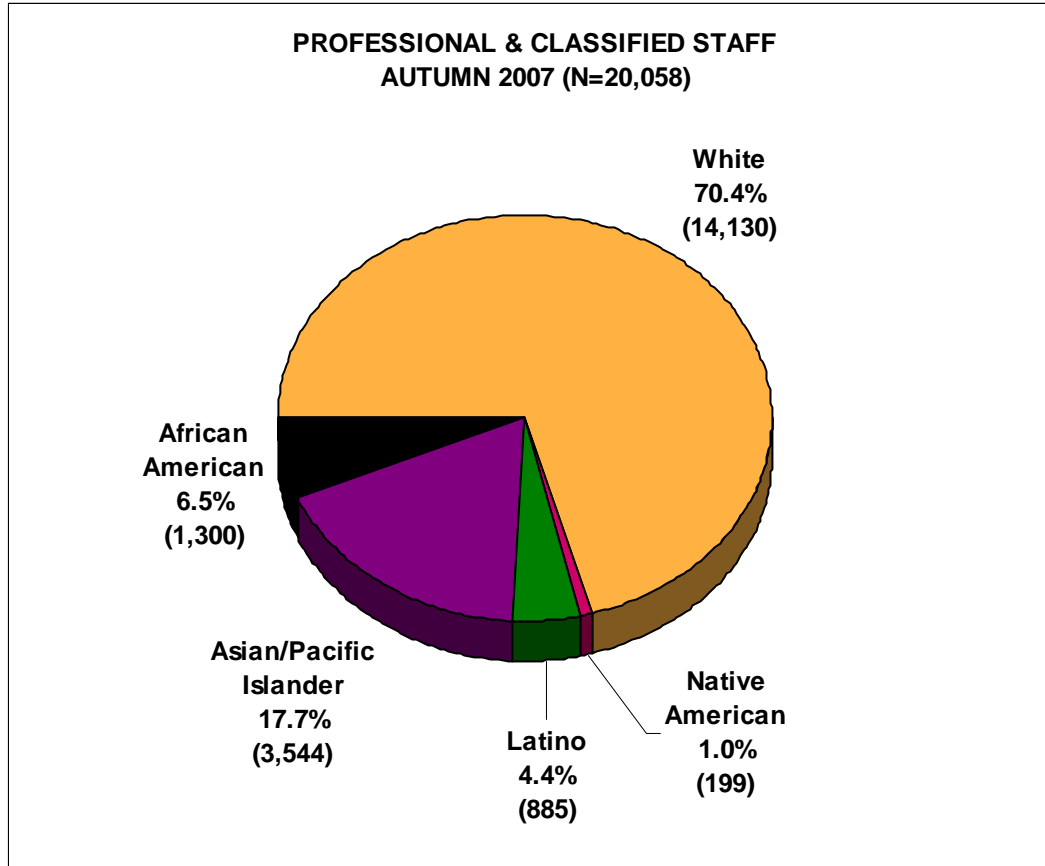
