DO-IT Affiliates engage in DO-IT projects in a variety of ways, including participation in college transition fairs, field trips, and career fairs; coordinating a special event or internship opportunity for students with disabilities; joining a DO-IT community of practice; or engaging with students with disabilities online as a mentor.

DO-IT (Disabilities, Opportunities, Internetworking, and Technology), at the University of Washington, brings together successful practices and builds on established collaborations with K-12 and postsecondary faculty and staff, industry professionals, and other disability practitioners, to increase the success of individuals with disabilities in education and their transition to careers.

DO-IT serves to increase the successful participation of individuals with disabilities in challenging academic programs and careers, such as those in science, engineering, mathematics, and technology. Primary funding for DO-IT is provided by the National Science Foundation, the State of Washington, and the U.S. Department of Education.



DO-IT Affiliates gain:

- Staff training to increase disability awareness and share strategies for including students with disabilities.
- Information and consultation about making webpages, facilities, and labs accessible.
- Free handouts and videos for training sessions.
- Free images of students with disabilities engaging in academic studies and employment for online and print publications.
- Assistance with publications, curriculum, and program activities to ensure the full inclusion of students with disabilities.
- Participation of students with disabilities in your programs.

Affiliates contribute to DO-IT efforts by:

- Recruiting students to attend DO-IT activities including college transition fairs, field trips, and career fairs.
- Including images of students with disabilities in your program promotional materials and recruitment efforts.
- Maximizing the inclusion of students with disabilities in your curriculum and program activities.
- Identifying or coordinating a special event or internship opportunity with DO-IT.
- Directing activities with some funding from DO-IT.
- Joining a DO-IT mentoring team to support students with disabilities or recruiting a colleague to be a mentor.
- Joining a community of practice to improve professional practices relative to the inclusion of people with disabilities.
