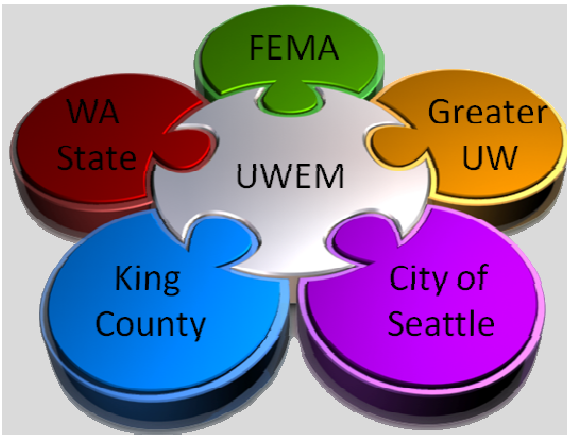

UW Emergency Management is the primary liaison and point-of-contact between UW departments/units and our key partners with the City of Seattle, King County, other State agencies, FEMA and the US Department of Homeland Security for all issues related to:

- ▶ **Disaster Management**

- ▶ **Hazards Management**
- ▶ **Campus Preparedness**

UWEM acts as your primary internal "consultant" to provide tools and resources for UW departments, units and campuses to develop their own unique plans and preparedness activities.

A Brief History & Highlights

2003-05

- UW Emergency Management (UWEM) established & Director hired on May 1, 2003
- Emergency Management Preparedness Committee formed with 11 charter members
- Campus Emergency Response Management Plan drafted and published
- First Federal UASI grant received (\$239K)
- UWEM becomes member of Campus Security Advisory and Health & Safety Committees
- Admin. Policy 13.1 "Emergency Mgmt." issued
- Initiated annual EOC drills (every April)
- First FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) published
- UWEM Webpage goes "live"
- Pilot CERT program established
- Debut of UW Internal Preparedness Grant program (\$100,000/Year)
- Initiated ICS system in the UW EOC
- DRU Phase II grant received (\$300K)
- UASI 04 grant received (\$746K)

2006– 2009

- First University to ever participate in FEMA's Integrated Emergency Management Course
- UWEM Webpage gets over 2000 "hits" daily
- Pilot Business Continuity Program begun
- Host Best Practices Symposium & QuakeFest
- Balanced Scorecard Program Developed
- UASI 05 and 07 grants received (\$805K and \$208K)
- Received 2 FEMA mitigation grants (\$1.6M)
- Coordinated UW's pandemic flu planning
- First 5-year Strategic Plan Developed

Future Initiatives (2010 and Beyond)

- Relocate the campus Emergency Operations Center (EOC) out of the Bryant Building
- Increase outreach to academic units, research departments and the general student body
- Implement standardized disaster recovery processes
- Obtain emergency management accreditation
- Automate EOC information-sharing system
- Mentor other universities
