Postdoctoral scholars are an integral part of the academic environment at the University of Washington, and contribute extensively to the missions of teaching, research, and service. Holding limited appointments, postdoctoral scholars are funded through institutional resources, research grants, and training grants. Postdoctoral titles at the University include Research Associate, Research Associate Trainee, Senior Fellow, and Senior Fellow Trainee, all of which serve on the Seattle, Bothell or Tacoma campuses.

* Information is based on data as of 10/31/2007. Units not listed did not employ postdoctoral scholars on this date.

** Postdoctoral scholars attaining UW professorial titles reflect current professors in the listed school, college, or campus who held a postdoctoral title, regardless of unit, at the UW within the last ten years (10/31/1997 - 10/31/2007).

*** Aggregated Units represent combined totals for Architecture and Urban Planning, Business, Forest Resources, I-School, Nursing, Public Affairs, and Social Work, each of which reported less than five postdoctoral scholars at time of analysis.
