OIM initial three-phase work plan:

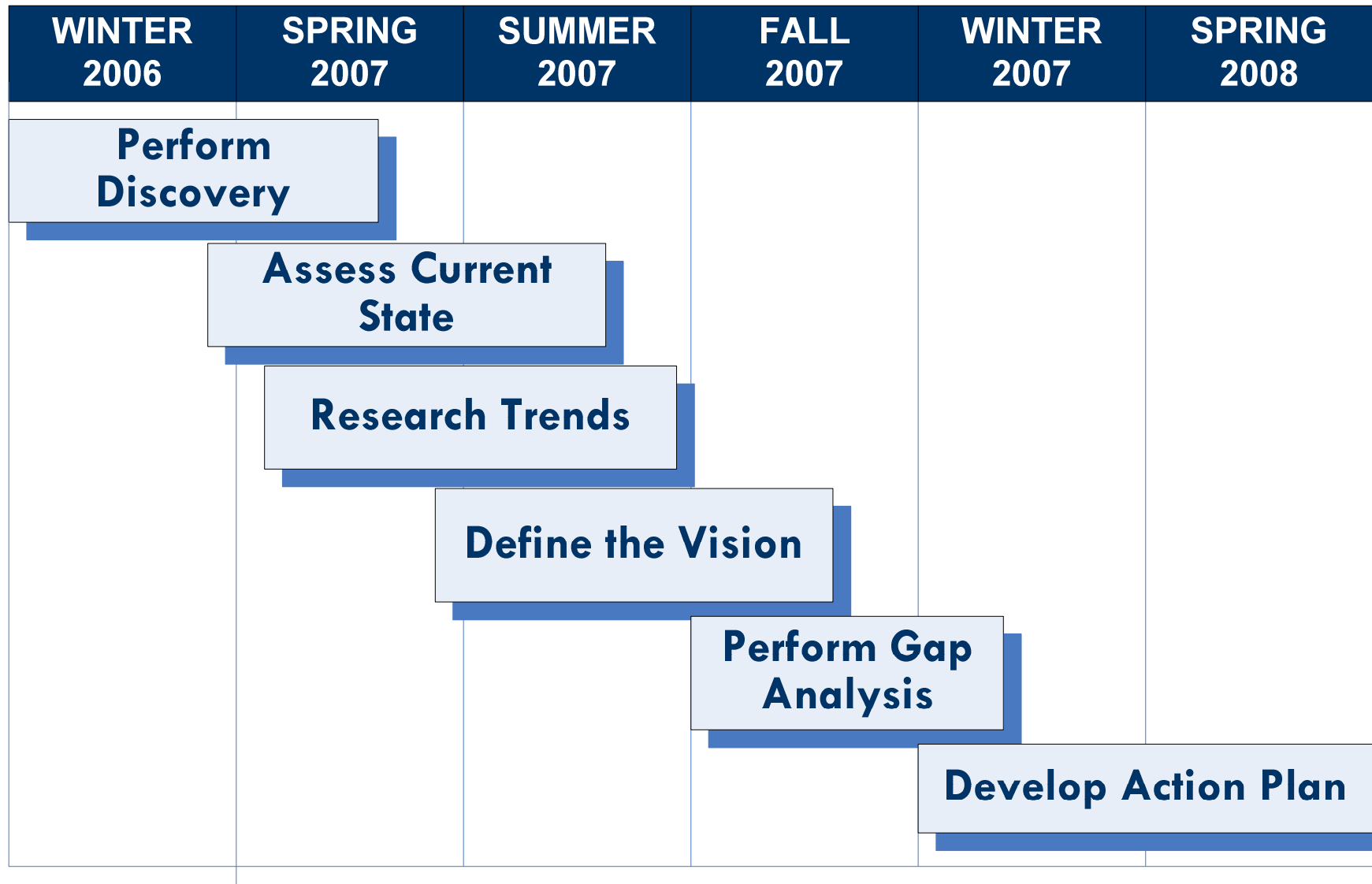
- **Discovery/Assessment:** Identify challenges and opportunities (Winter 2006-07)

Project Scope

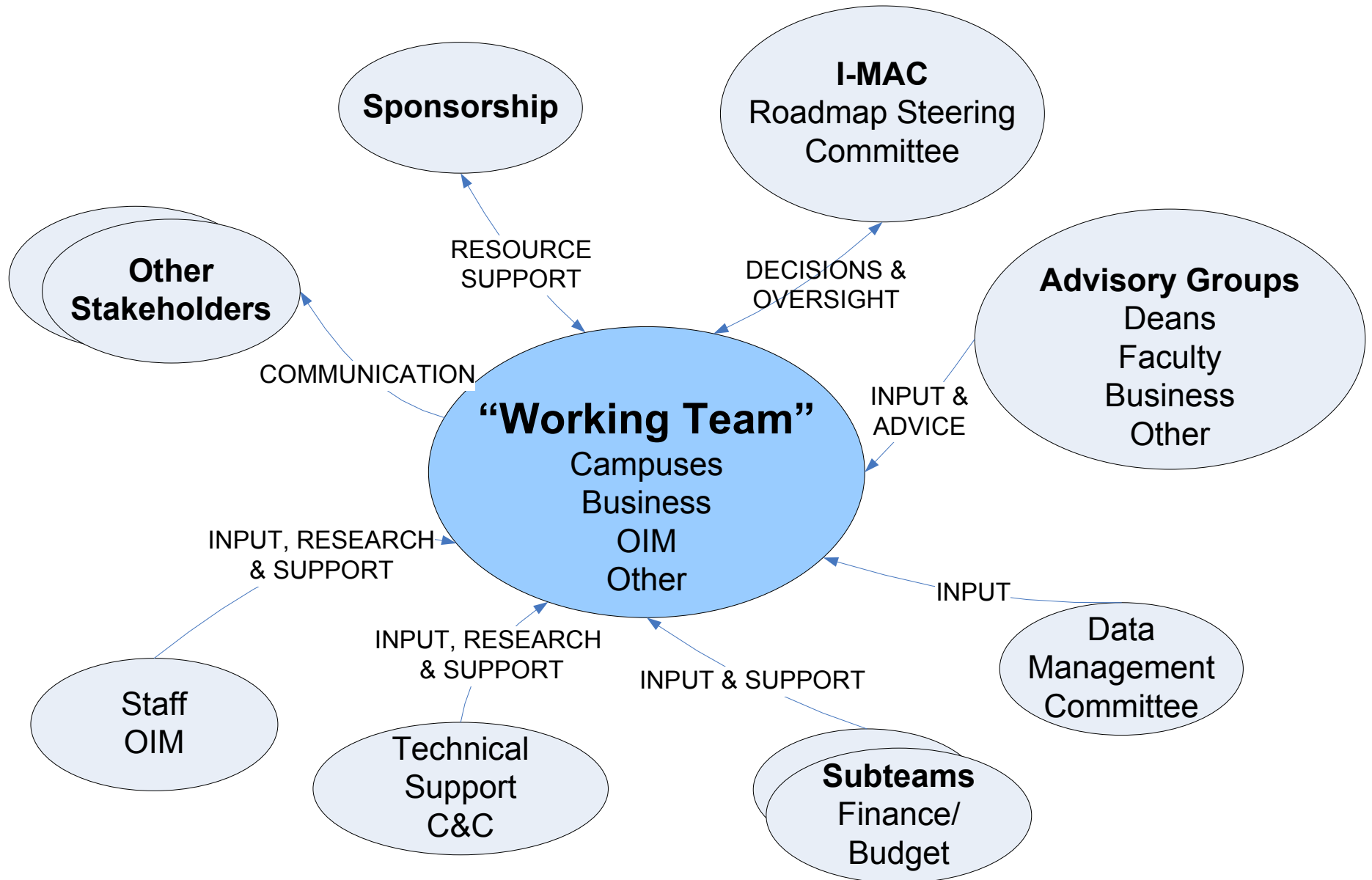
Organized Around Broad Themes from Discovery
