The Daily began as the Pacific Wave in 1891, only 30 years after the University of Washington was founded. It became The Daily in 1909 when the paper began publishing five days a week.

The Daily is produced exclusively by students. Any UW student may apply for work at The Daily and will be paid for his or her work. About 150 students work for The Daily at any one time, in a variety of positions in our newsroom, new media, advertising and accounting departments.

The Daily aspires to build a publication that represents the diversity of populations on campus (cultural, socioeconomic and academic), within the business and throughout the news content.
