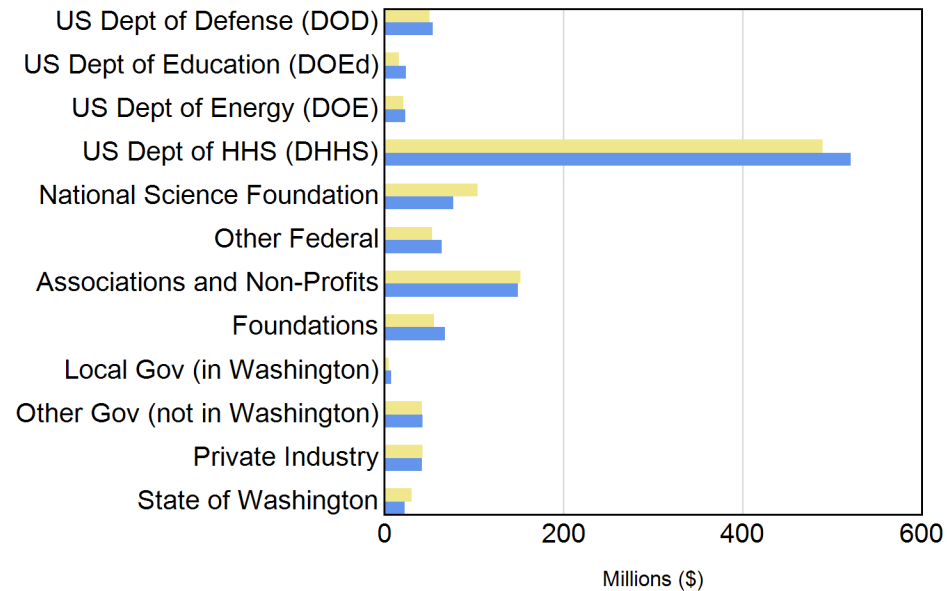
**Fiscal Year to Date**

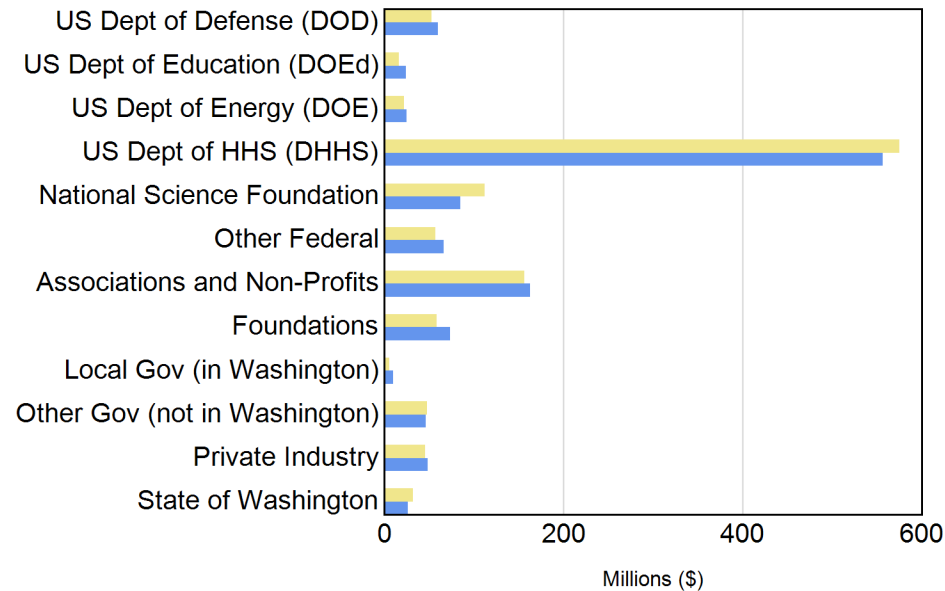
