


Fundraising Progress Since July 1, 2000

- •\$1,146,267,539 has been raised since July 1, 2000.
- •The UW received \$17.6 million in total private voluntary support (\$7.7 million in gifts and \$10 million in grants) in August.
- •Areas including Architecture, Dentistry, Education, Evans School, Forest Resources, Information School, ICA, Libraries, Nursing, Pharmacy, Social Work, University Press, UW Bothell and UW Tacoma are ahead of last years year-to-date totals.

August Gifts and Impact

Selected gifts representing private support by UW alumni of one or more of the University of Washington's key fundraising priorities - student, faculty, program and facility support

Andy Warhol Foundation for the Visual Arts - \$60,000 to the Henry Art Gallery

- -The Warhol Foundation's gift will support the direct costs of *Hershmanlandia: The Art and Films of Lynn Hershman Lesson*, an exhibition premiering at the Henry Art Gallery in November 2005.
- -This exhibit, which will will tour internationally after its display at the Henry, is the first major U.S. survey of the work of Lynn Hershman Lesson, a San Francisco artist and filmmaker.
- -The UW's Henry Art Gallery opened in 1927 as the first public art museum in the state. The museum's renovation and expansion, completed in April 1997, quadrupled its size. Over the years, it has gained an international reputation for its exhibitions of contemporary and modern art.
- -The Warhol Foundation encourages and supports cultural organizations that in turn support artists and their work. The Foundation focuses primarily on work of a challenging nature.

Michael B. Jeffers - \$25,000 to the School of Law

- -This gift will benefit the Gerry Alexander Fund for Professional Responsibility, honoring Washington State Supreme Court Chief Justice Gerry Alexander.
- -Michael Jeffers ('64), chaired the Class of 1964's effort to establish this endowed fund, which was announced at a reunion dinner in July 2004, in honor of their classmate.
- -The fund will used to support the advancement of professional responsibility by acquiring library materials, funding legal research and student interactive projects, and sponsoring distinguished lectures on professional responsibility. It may eventually become an endowed professorship.
- -Justice Alexander is known for promoting professional responsibility in his field, with emphasis on educating students and lawyers on ethical and professional responsibilities.
- -Alumni have given and pledged almost \$60,000 to the fund to date, though due to judicial ethics, Justice Alexander cannot be told the names of those who contribute to the fund.

Washington State Combined Fund Drive Participants - \$2,348 to UW Tacoma

- -This gift represents the combined donations from state of Washington employees to the UW Tacoma Fund for Excellence during the 2003-04 Washington State Combined Fund Drive.
- -The Combined Fund Drive was created in 1984 to condense multiple fundraising campaigns soliciting state employees for money and volunteer time into a single effort.
- -The first campaign in 1985 raised \$1.2 million. In fifteen years, state employees have contributed over \$51 million to sixteen hundred charities here and around the world, including many funds at the University of Washington. For the 2003-04 year, UW student scholarships, fellowships and other programs received \$16,617 in employee donations as a result of the CFD.
- -The UW Tacoma Fund for Excellence plays an important role in promoting expanded student access and instructional excellence for the UW Tacoma campus, and allows the Chancellor the flexibility to reward and encourage excellence. Gifts are used to cover immediate or unexpected campus needs and to promote the continued growth of the campus.







Complete Fiscal Year Comparison of Total Contributions Received






