Committee on the UW Undergraduate ExperienceProposed charge

This committee will be charged to:

- Report to the president and provost regarding the vision and goals for the UW undergraduate experience with a focus on the Seattle campus:
 - What should be the attributes of an excellent undergraduate experience at the University of Washington?

and

- Identify:
 - The strengths of the current UW experience
 - The weaknesses of the current UW experience
 - Principles or question that would underlie the organization of the undergraduate experience at the UW

In carrying out this charge the committee might want to examine both national best practices related to the undergraduate experience and current UW surveys of undergraduate students. The committee is asked to view the undergraduate experience broadly, considering both formal academic programs and learning that takes place inside the classroom, and the other outside-the-classroom experiences that support the undergraduate learning experience and student life. The committee is also asked to consult with all stakeholders.

- Gather information – end of summer
- Conduct meetings, symposia, focus groups, retreat, and additional research – fall quarter
- Verbal report to the provost by Nov 15, with written report to the President and the Provost by Nov 30.
