

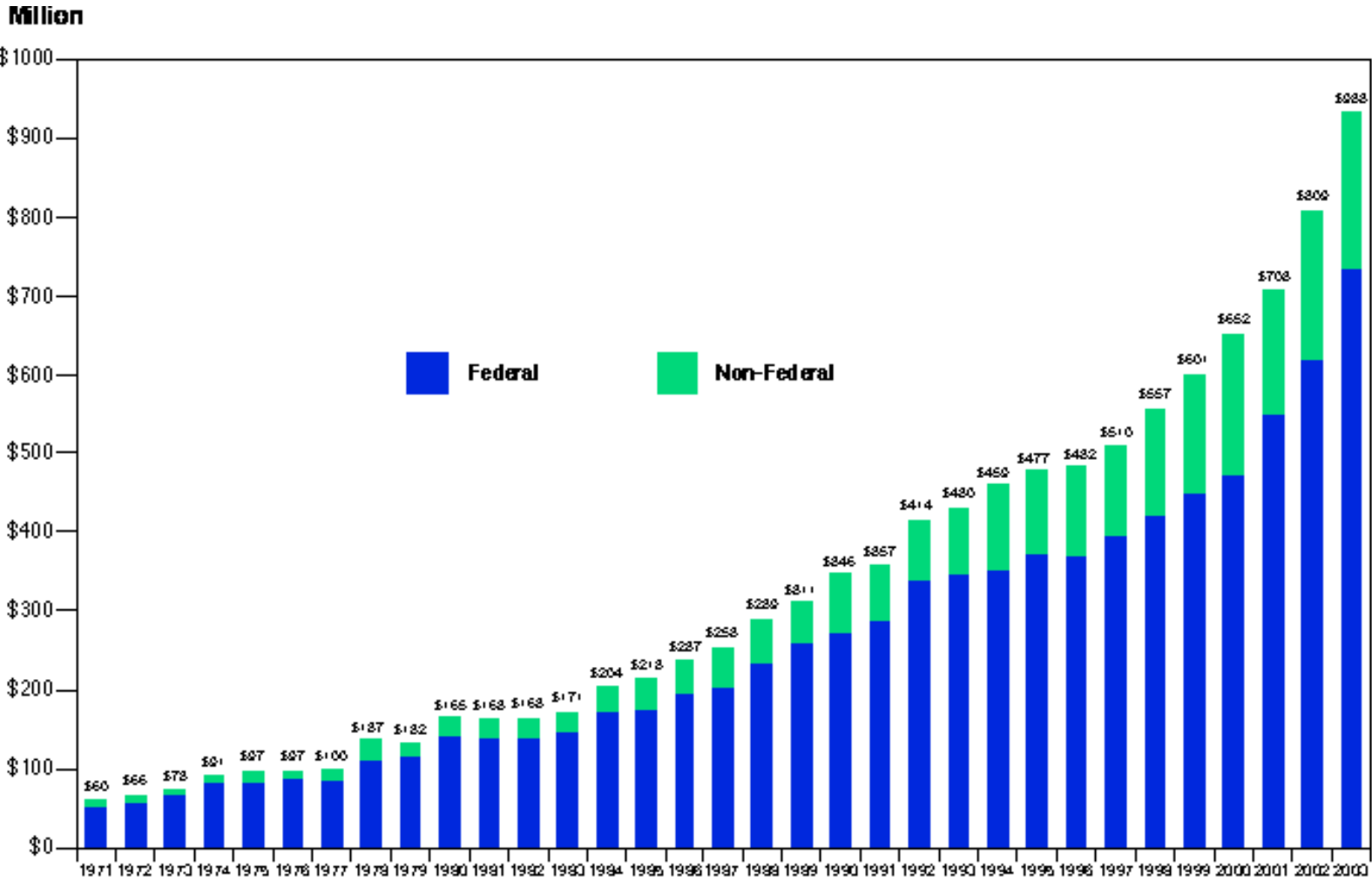

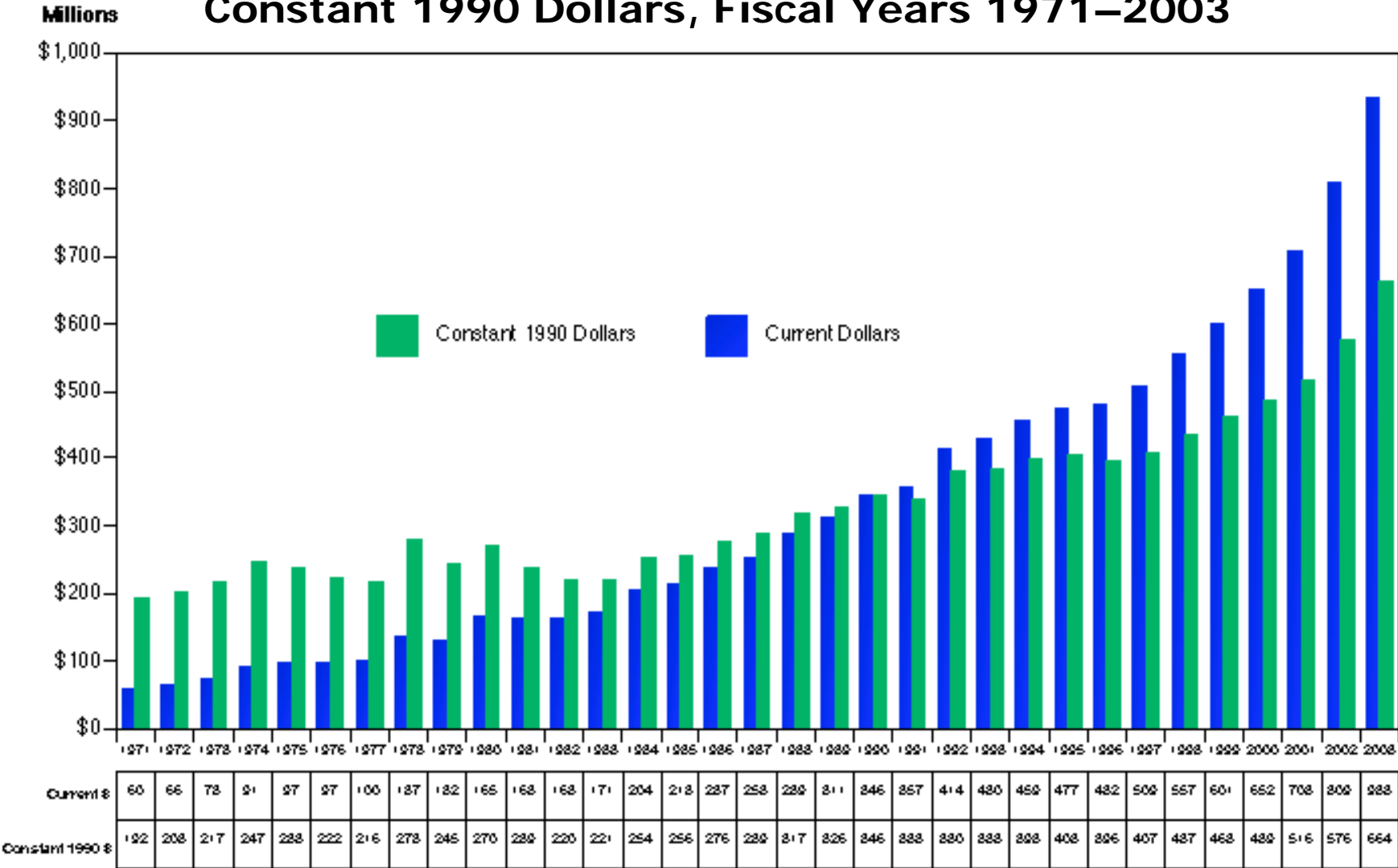

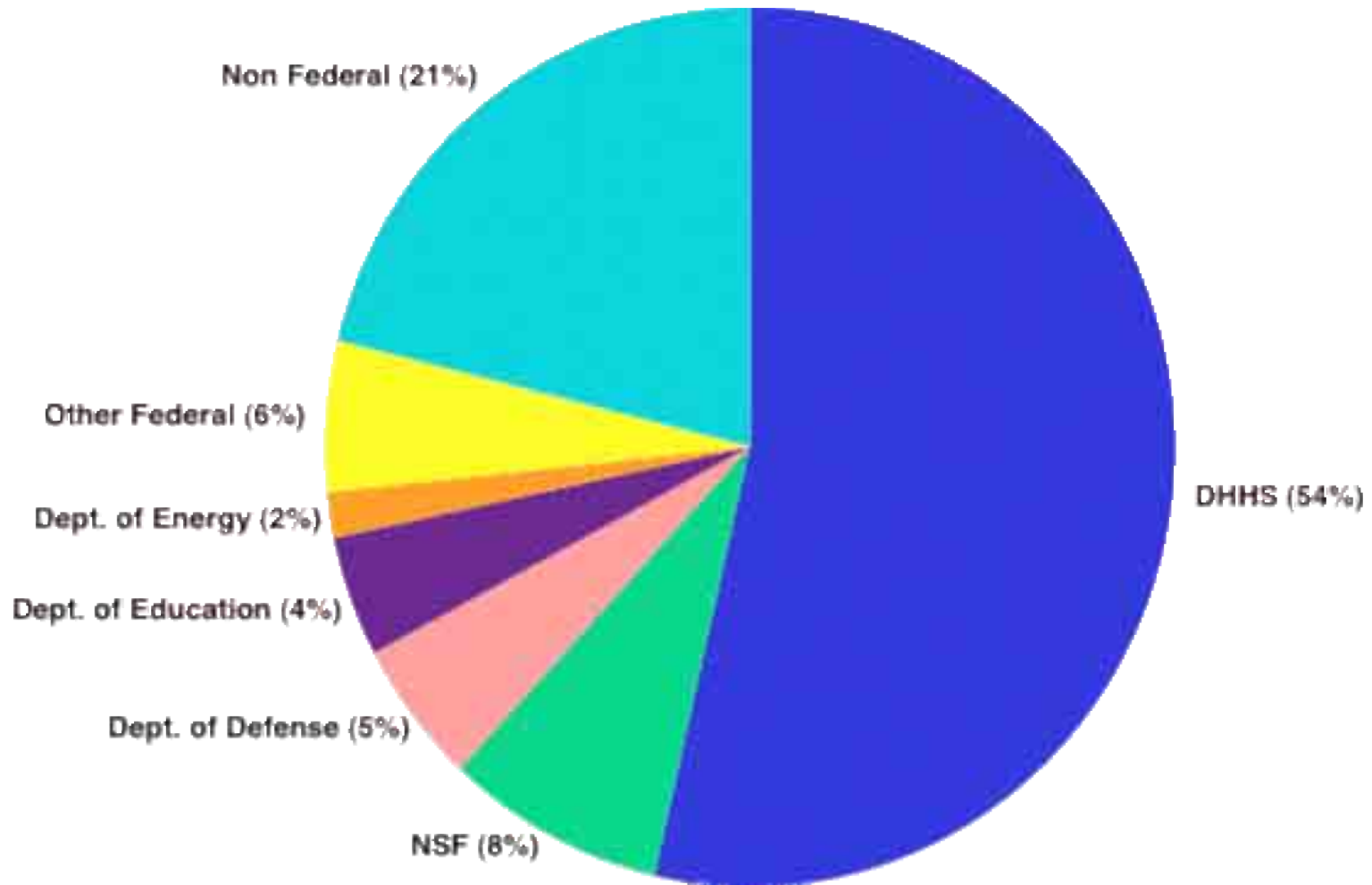
University of Washington Grant and Contract Award Totals, Fiscal Years 1971–2003

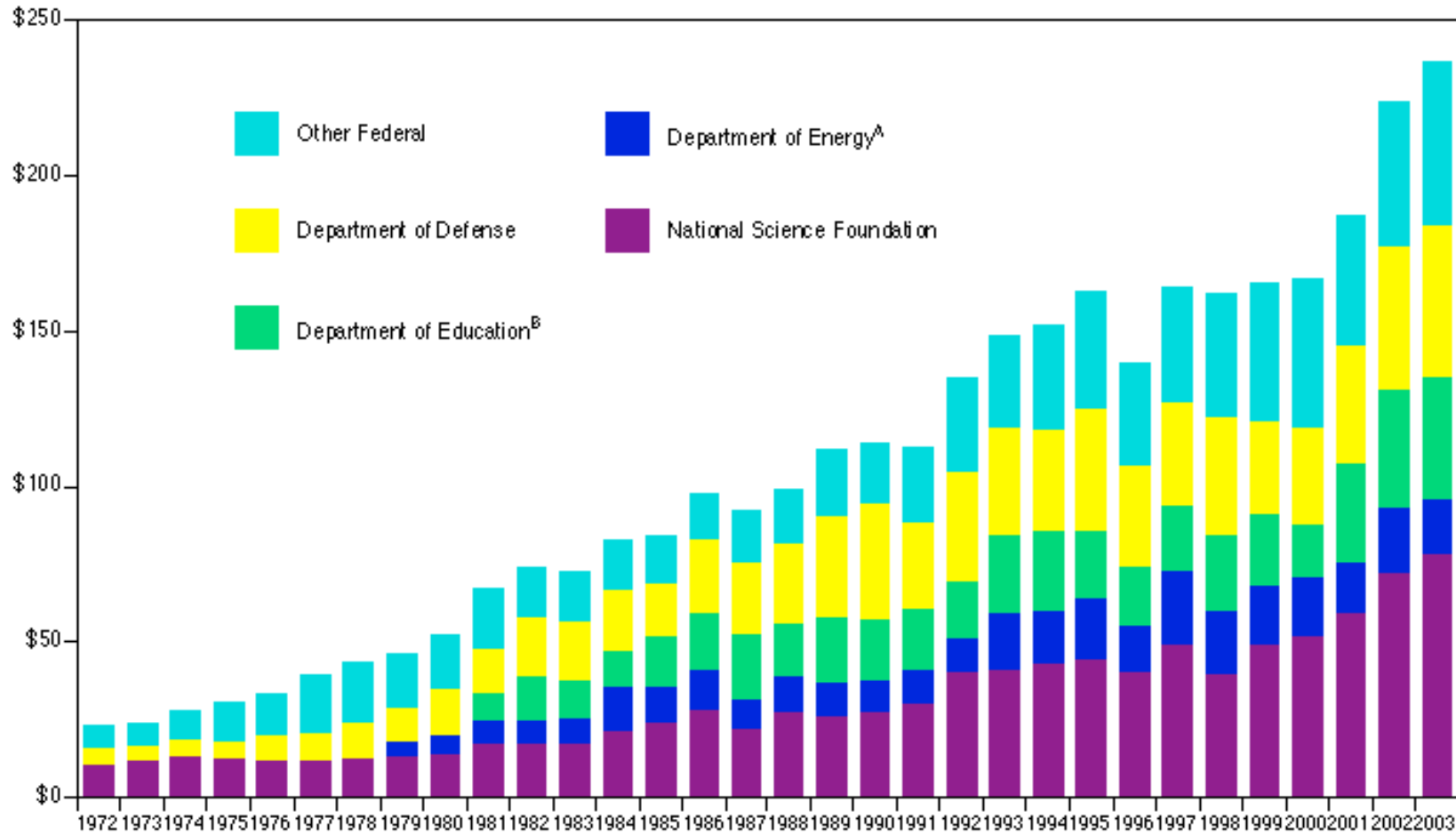

Major Sources of Federal Funds, Not Including the Dept. of Health and Human Services, 1972–2003

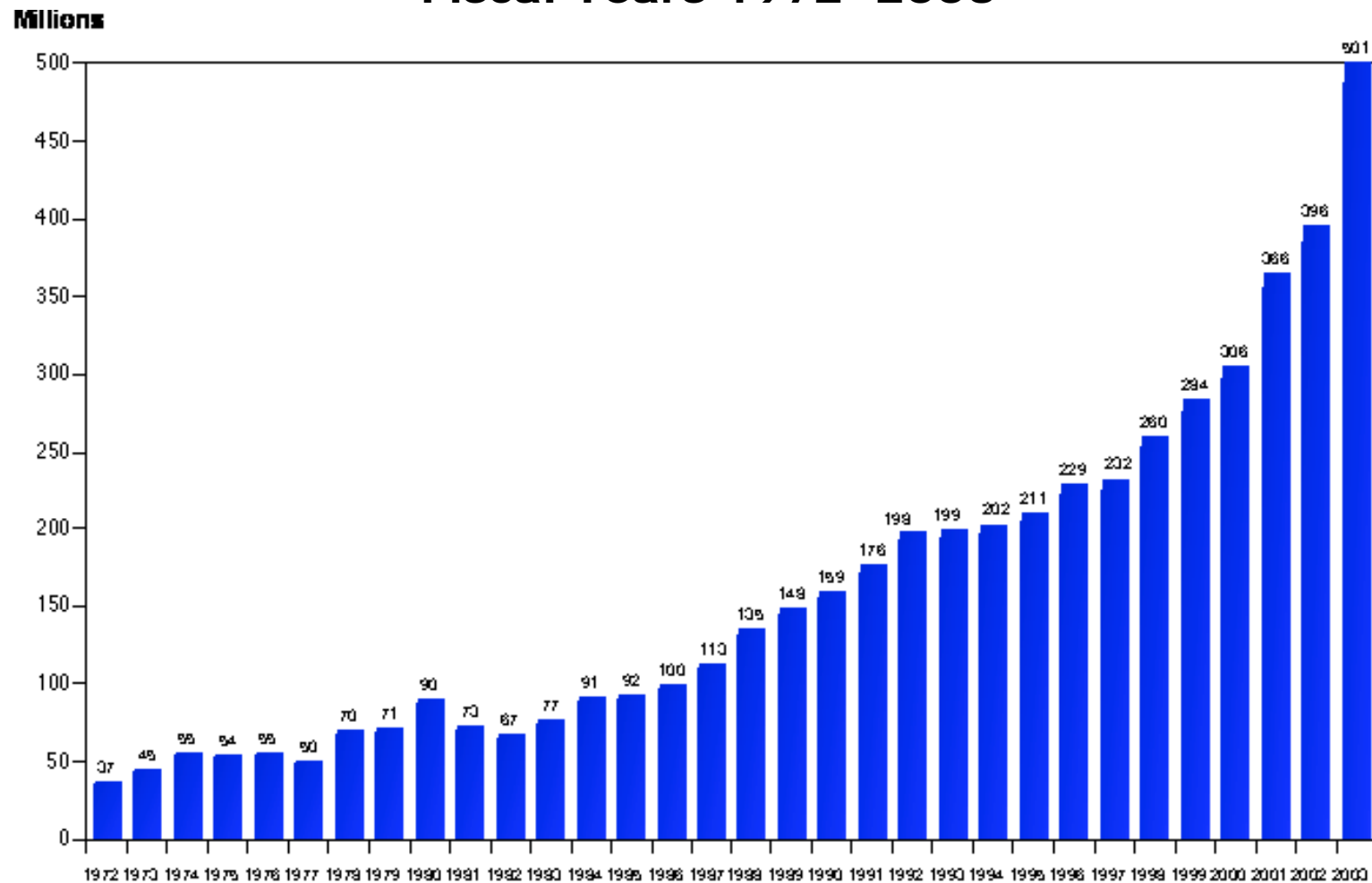

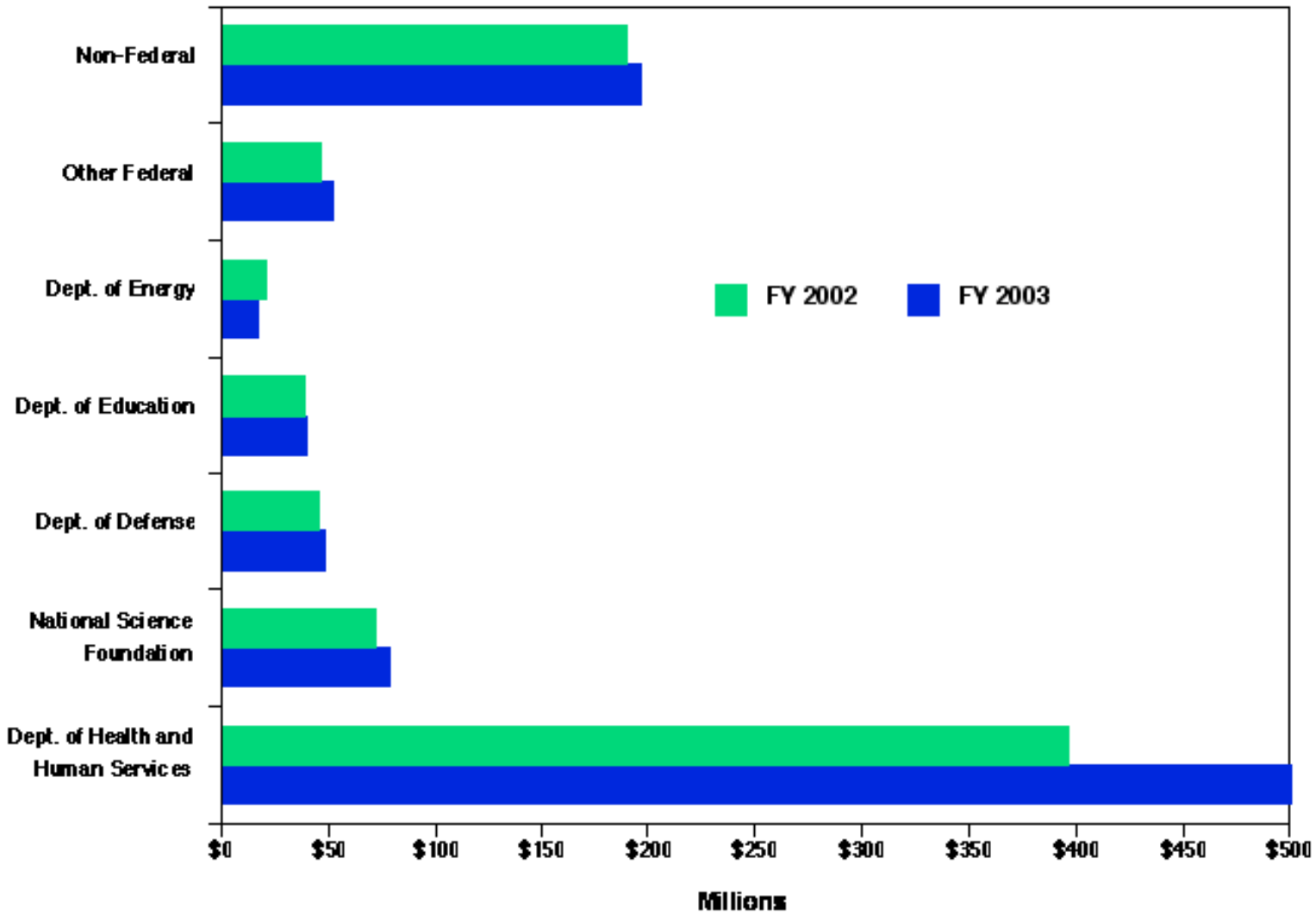

Funding from the Department of Health and Human Services, Fiscal Years 1972–2003

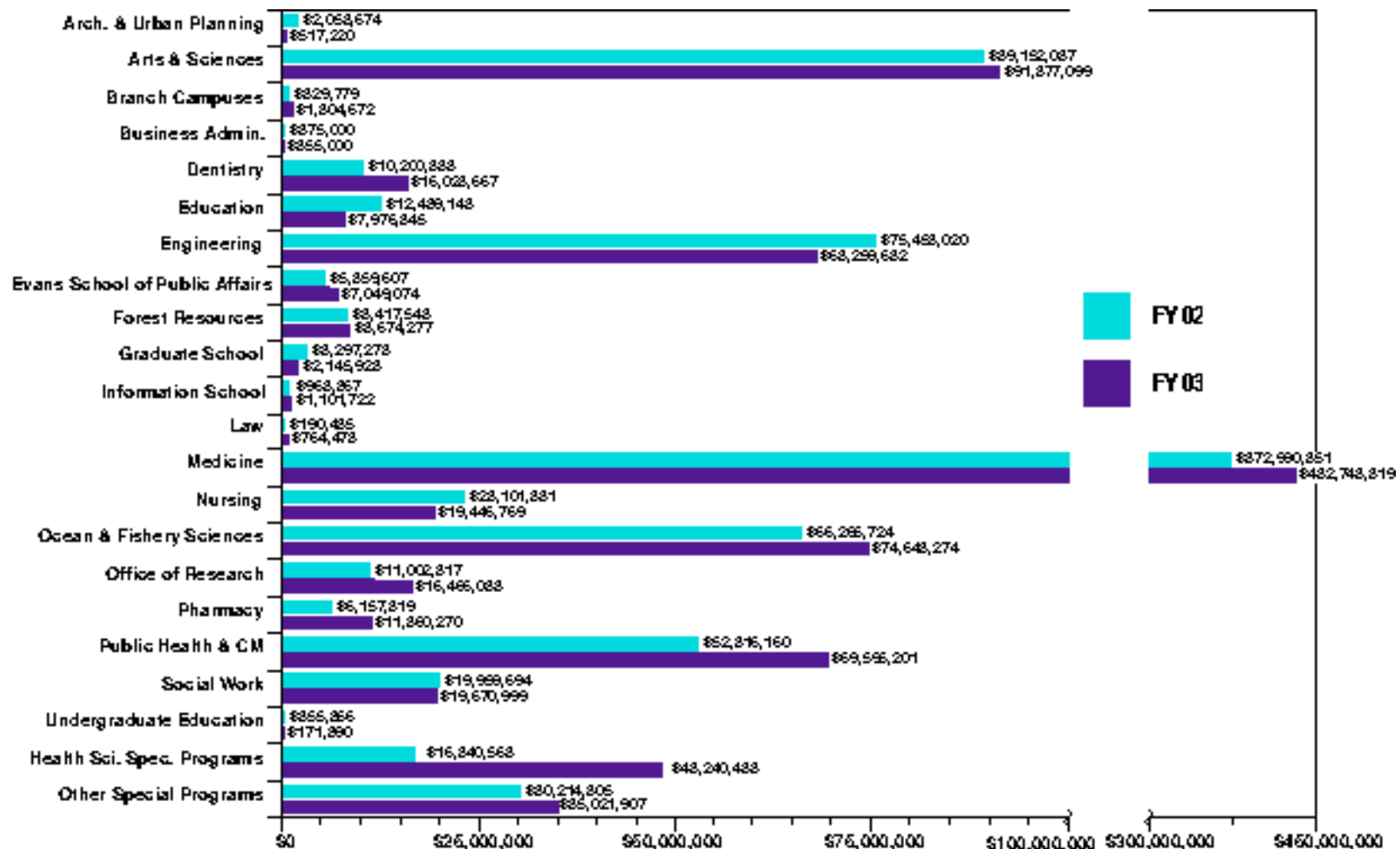

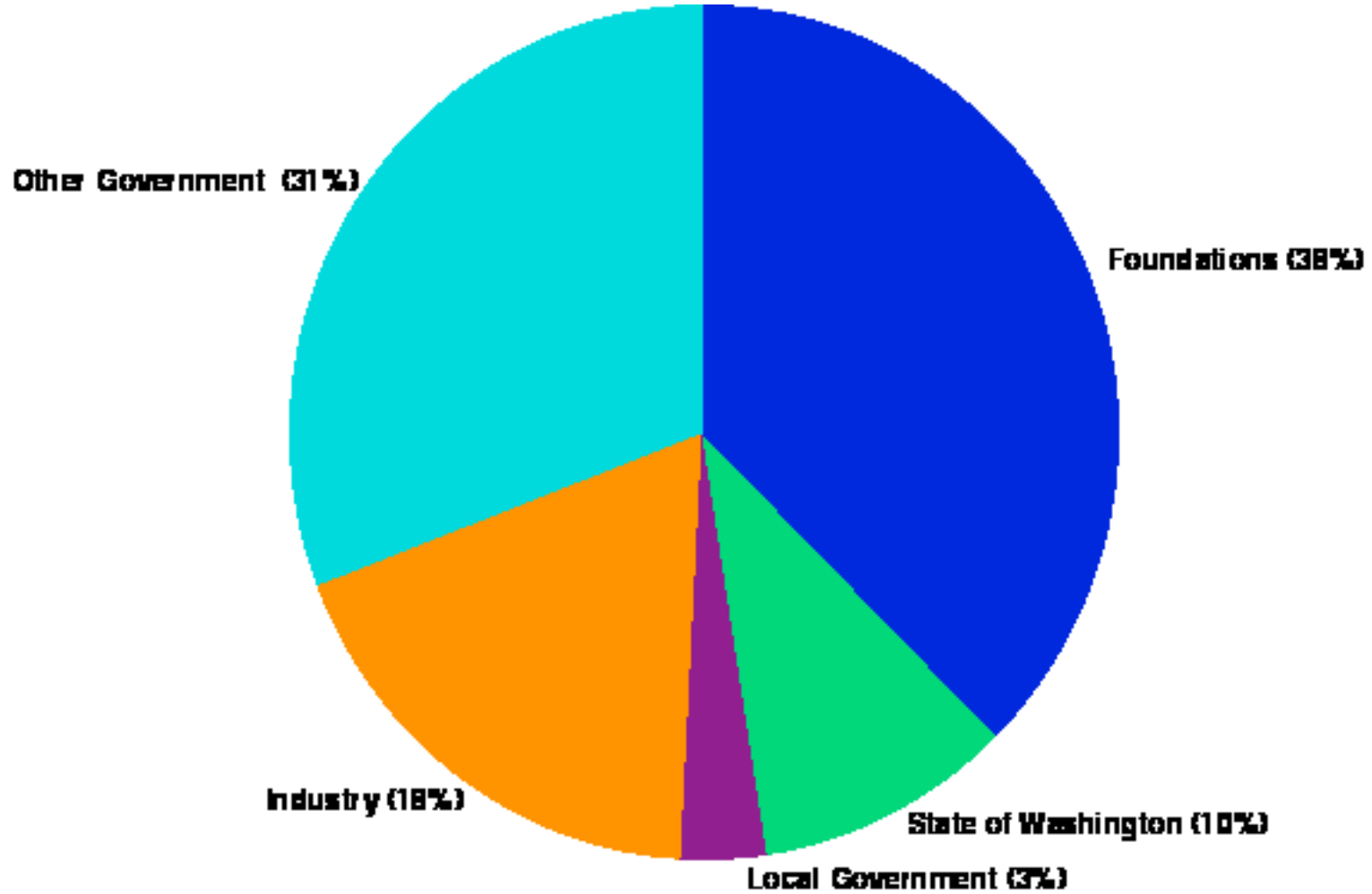
Two Year Comparison of Grant and Contract Awards by Source, Fiscal Years 2002-2003



Total Grant and Contract Awards by School/College/Unit, FY02–FY03



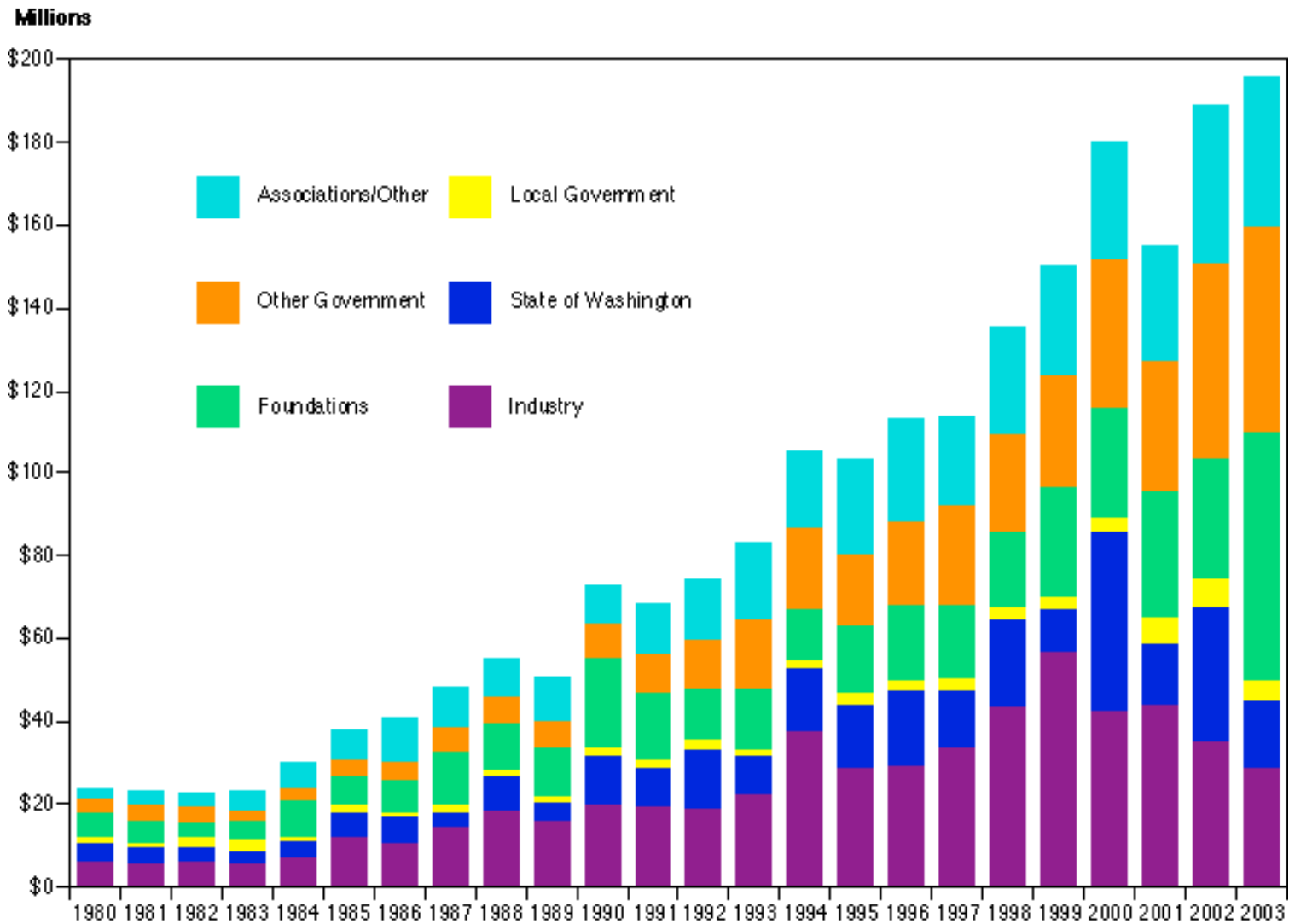

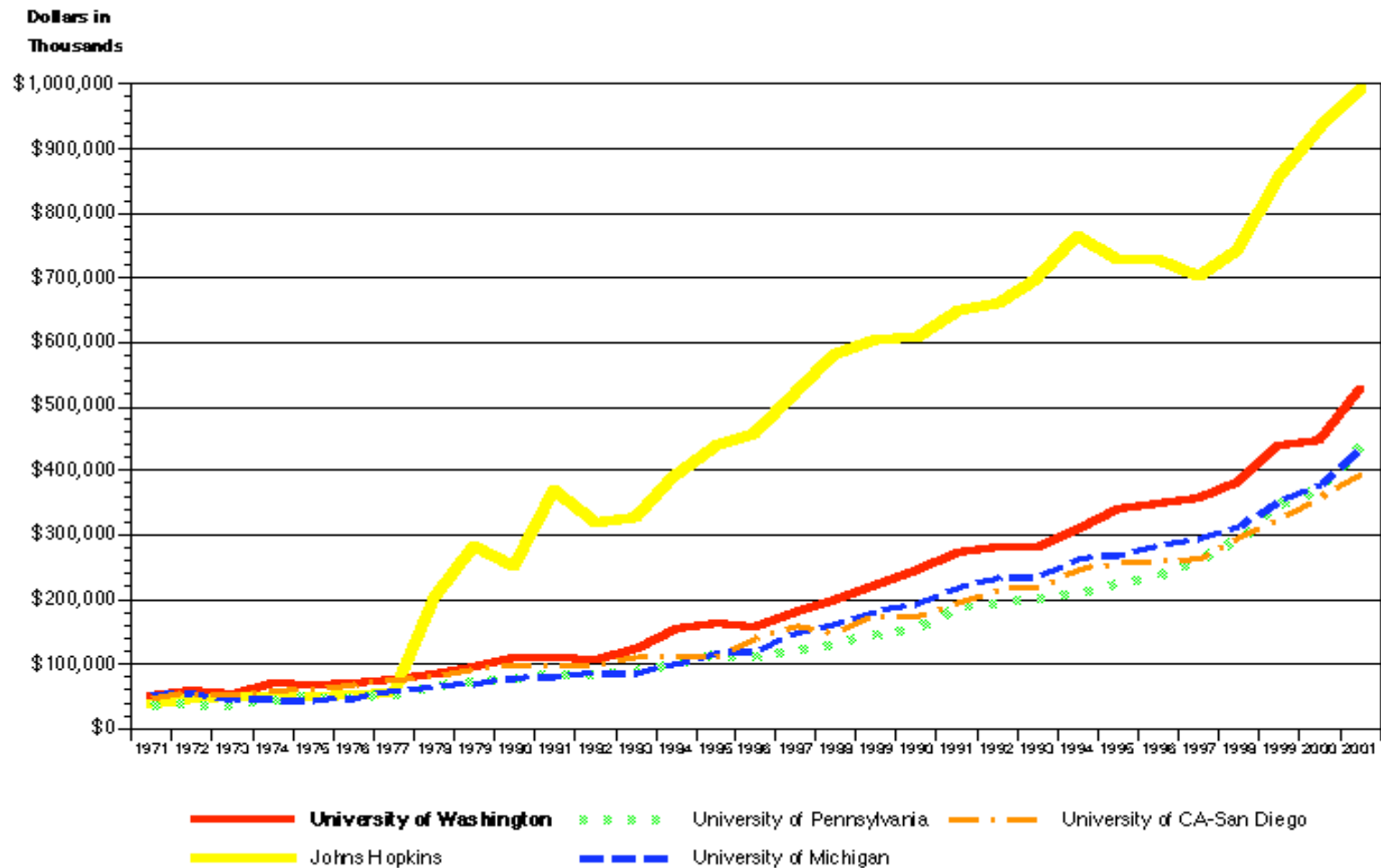

Sources of Non-Federal Research Funds, 1980–2003

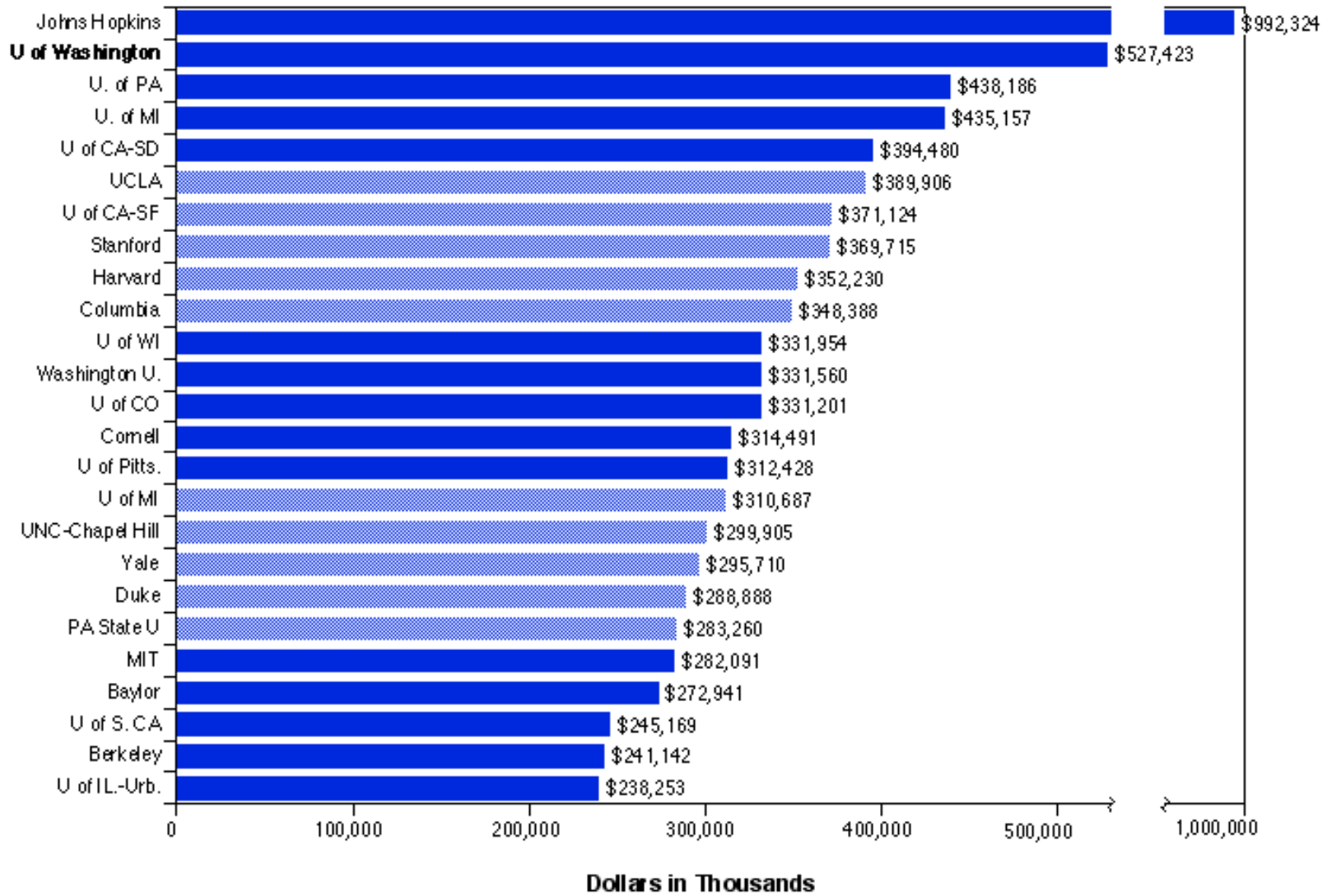

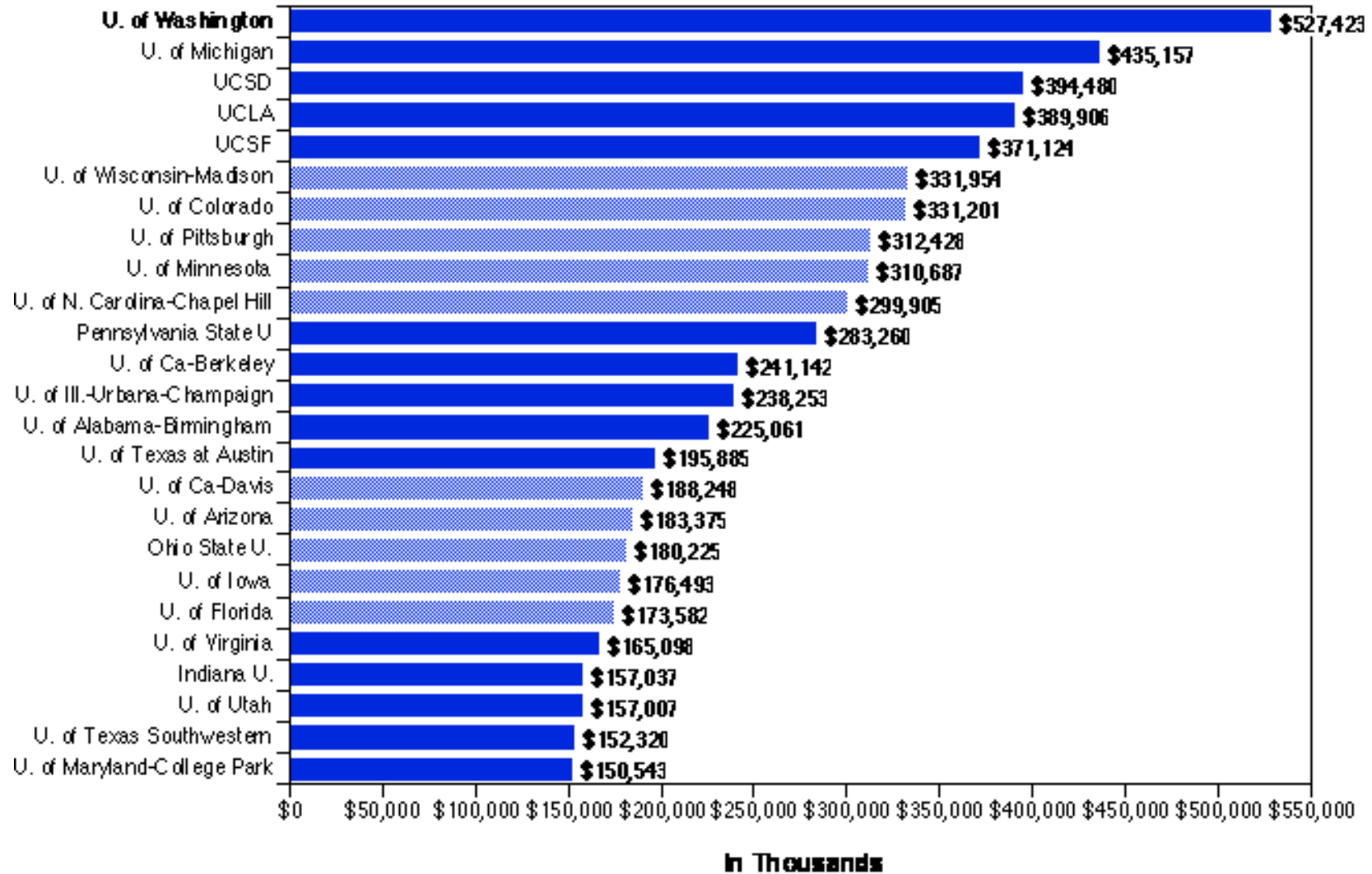
Federal Obligations for Science and Engineering to Top 5 Institutions, Fiscal Years 1971–2001



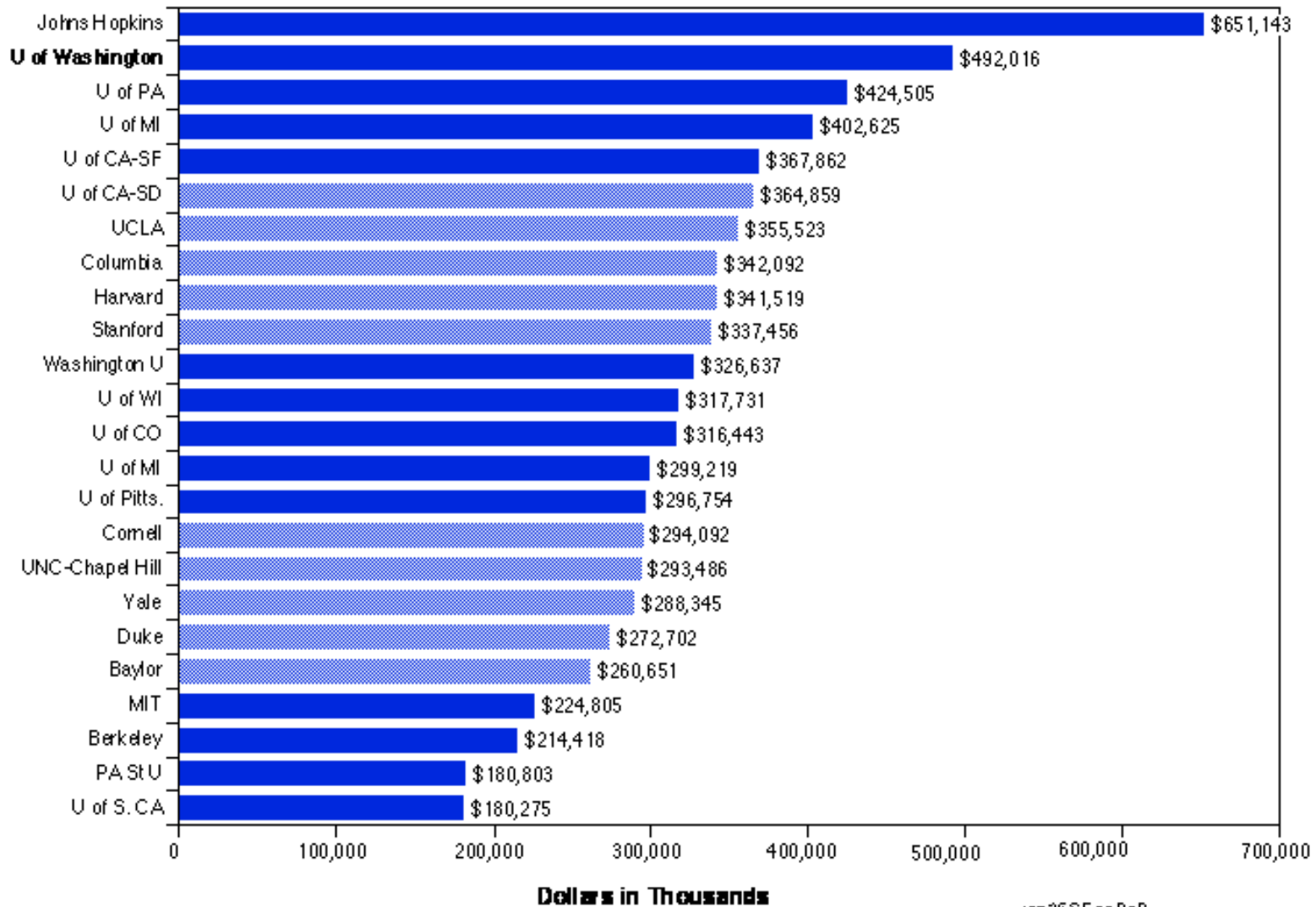
Top 25 Institutions, Ranked by Total Federal Obligations for Science and Engineering, FY 2001



Top 25 Public Institutions, Ranked by Federal Obligations for Science and Engineering Fiscal Year 2001

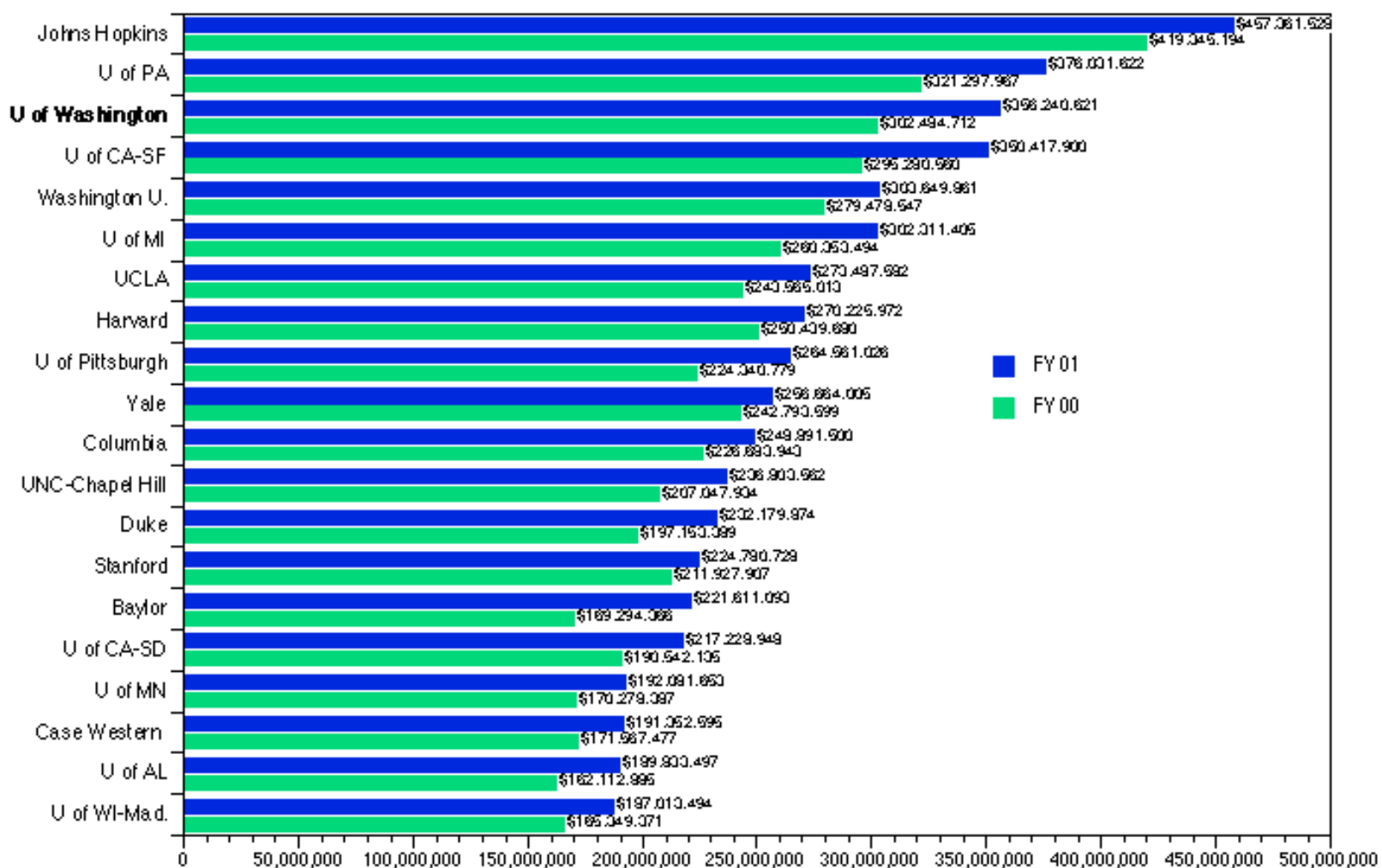


Top 25 Institutions, Ranked by Total Federal Obligations for Science and Engineering, without Dept. of Defense Funding, FY01

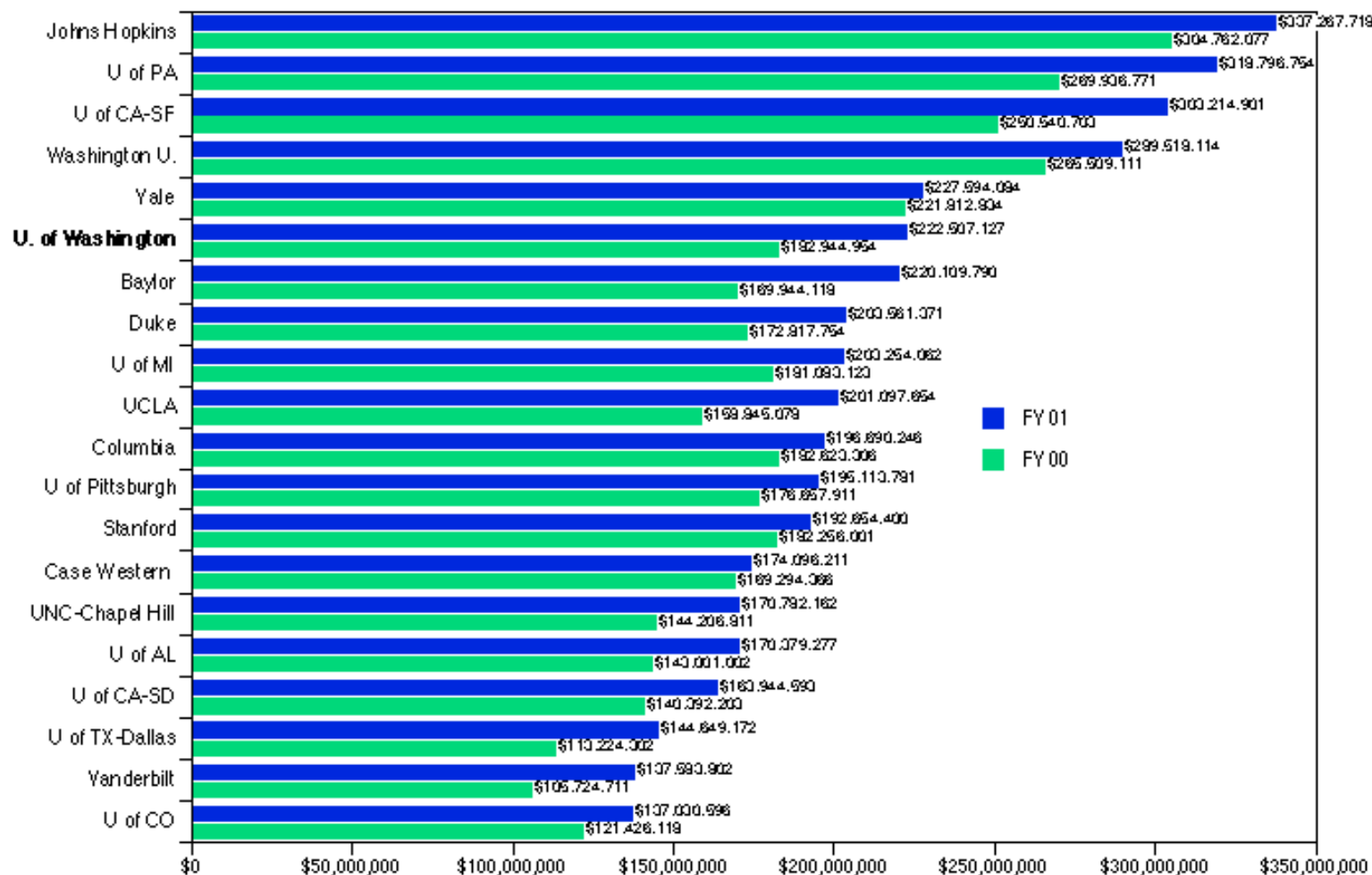

Top 20 Institutions, Ranked by Total Funding from the National Institutes of Health, Fiscal Years 2000–2001

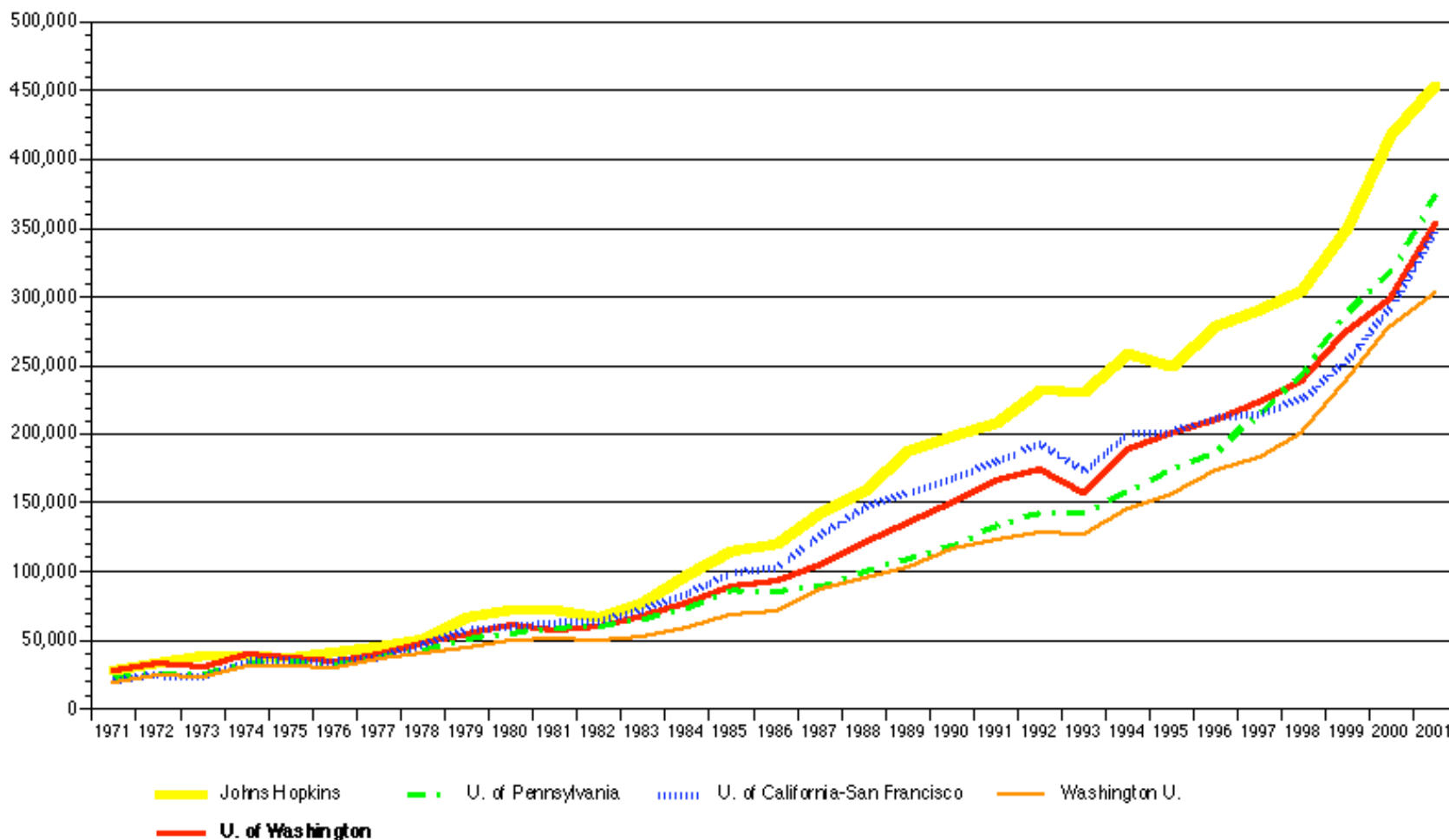


Top 20 Institutions, Ranked by Medical School Funding from the National Institutes of Health, Fiscal Years 2000-2001

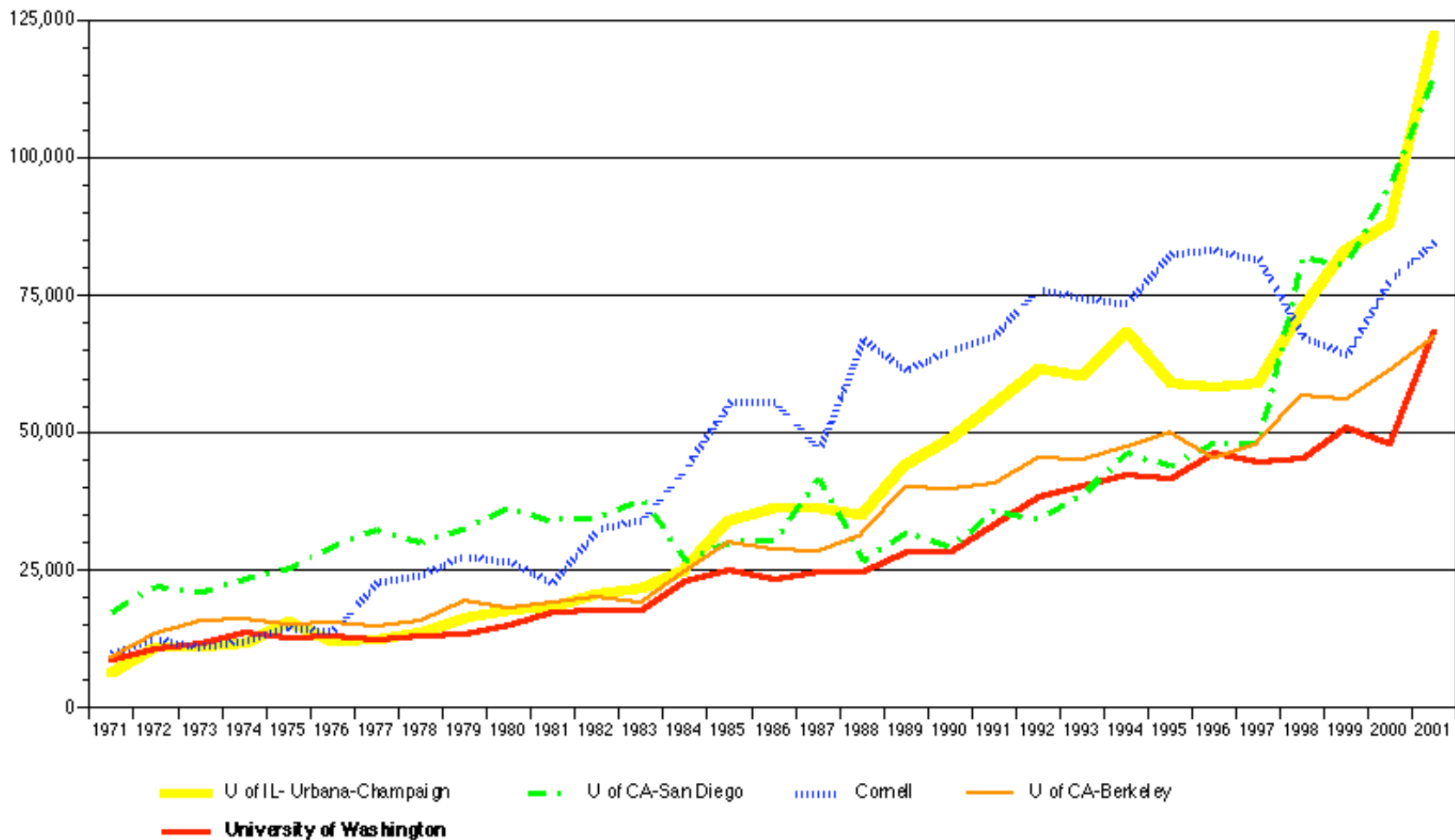

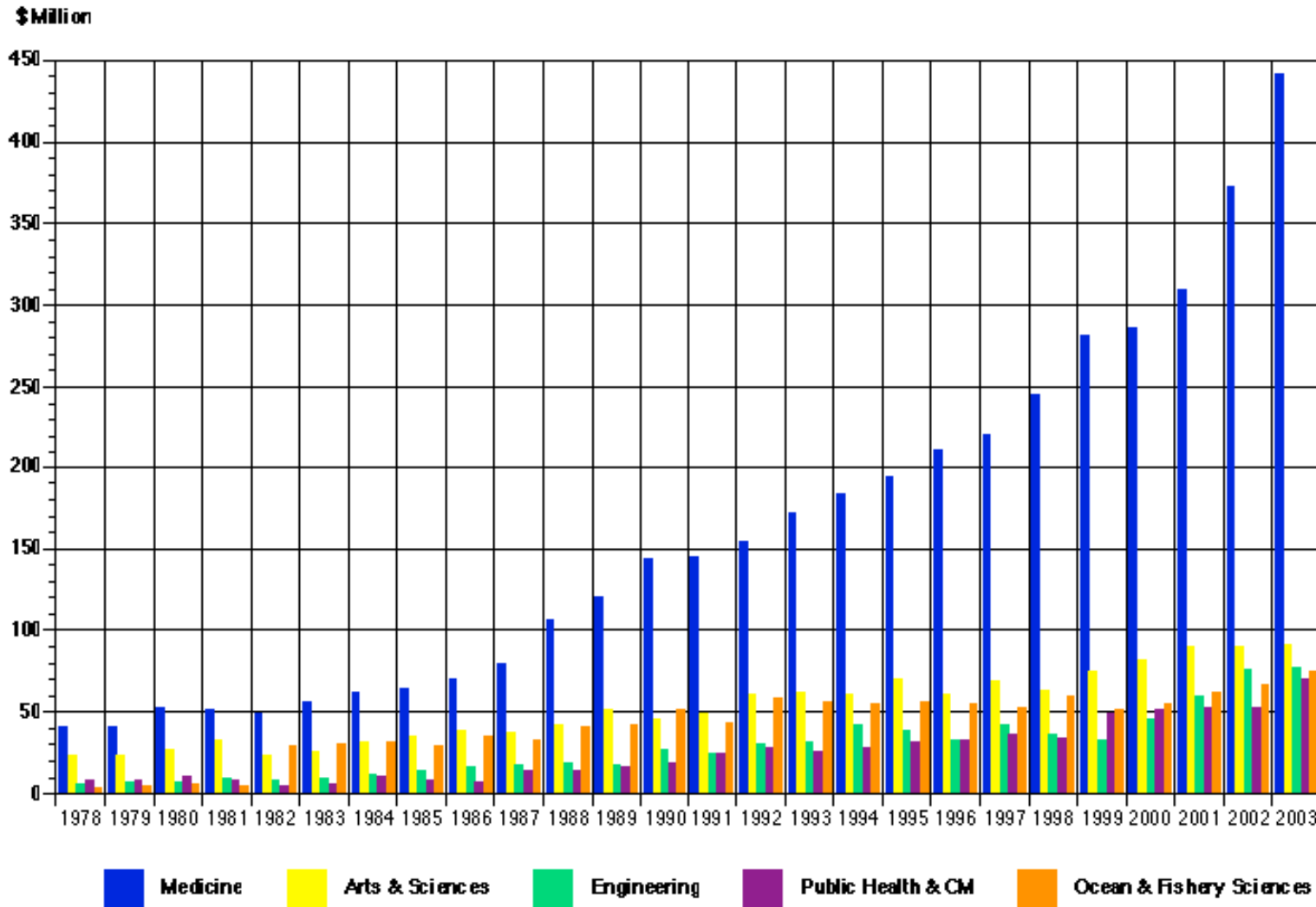
National Science Foundation Obligations for Science and Engineering to Top Five Institutions, Fiscal Years 1971-2001

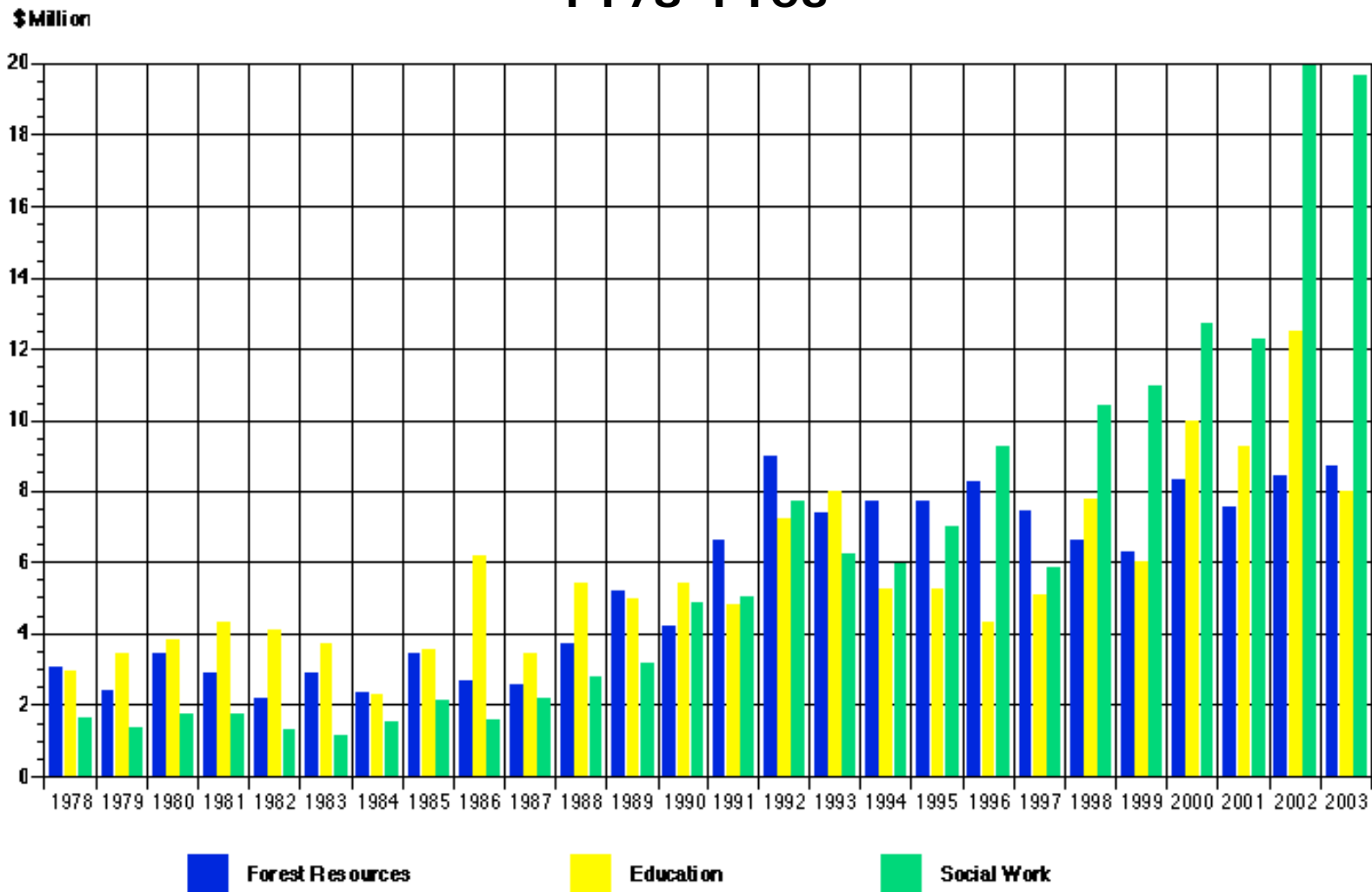

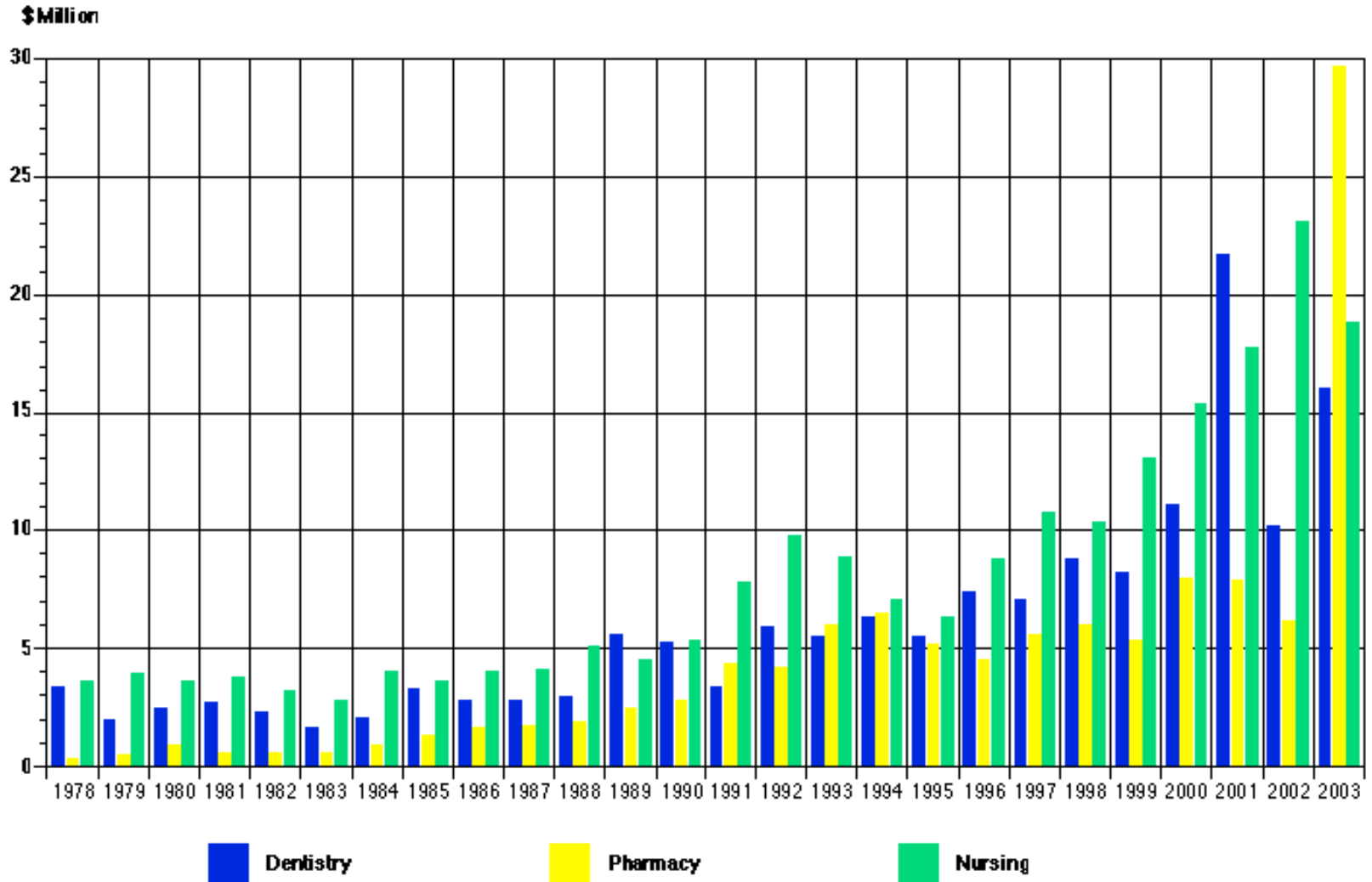
