

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. I understand that I must be a citizen of the United States or in this country on a permanent visa or meet the other criteria outlined in the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
2. I understand that I must be admitted to and enrolled in an eligible program at the University of Washington to receive Financial Aid.
3. I understand that the aid offered is for a full-time course load (12 credits undergraduate, 10 credits graduate and 12 credits professional students) unless otherwise specified on this letter in Section II. I agree that if I withdraw or cease to attend or carry the required number of credits, I will notify the Office of Student Financial Aid and, if necessary, arrange for the repayment of aid advanced to me for which I am no longer eligible.
4. I understand that I must maintain satisfactory academic progress to receive Financial Aid. Financial Aid may be withheld or canceled for failure to make satisfactory progress. This means that I must complete my degree within an established time frame (5 years or 225 cumulative credits, whichever comes first, for a bachelor's degree or 6 years for a master's degree, 10 years for a doctoral degree), maintain a minimum cumulative grade-point average (2.0 for undergraduates; 3.0 for graduates), and successfully complete at least half-time credits each quarter for which aid is received and an annual credit requirement based on my enrollment. I understand that I am responsible for knowing the information in the leaflet, "Satisfactory Academic Progress for Financial Aid," published by the Office of Student Financial Aid.
5. I agree to accept the responsibility for timely repayment of any loans awarded to me. I will keep the University's Student Fiscal Services Office and other loan servicers with whom I have an outstanding loan informed of my most current address.
6. I understand that this offer of aid is dependent upon federal and state allocations to the University. Insufficient allocations may result in a reduction in the amount of aid or a change in the type of aid offered to me.
7. I understand that this award is based on information I have provided about my financial status. I agree to report to the Office of Student Financial Aid any changes in my financial situation, including, but not limited to: changes in marital status, Washington State residency status, any additional income, scholarships or other funds I may receive. This includes all departmental scholarships or stipends, RA or TA position, ROTC stipends, room or board allowances or subsidies, or any other source of support. I understand that these changes may result in a reduction of awards and/or require repayment of aid already received.
8. I agree to permit this award to pay tuition, fees, room and board, other current year charges and limited prior year charges on my University account, unless I indicate otherwise on this award letter (use Comments section below).
9. I certify and agree that I will comply with the additional conditions listed below if I am awarded and receive a STATE NEED GRANT:
 - A. I am a resident of the State of Washington, in accordance with RCW 28B.15.011-013;
 - B. I am registered at the University of Washington as at least a half-time undergraduate student and am making satisfactory progress toward completion of my degree or program objective;
 - C. I have applied for a Federal Pell Grant;
 - D. I am not pursuing a degree in theology;
 - E. I do not owe a refund or repayment on a STATE NEED GRANT, a Federal Pell Grant, or a Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, nor am I in default on a loan made, insured, or guaranteed under the Federal Perkins Student Loan, National Direct Student Loan, Federal Family Educational Loan programs, or William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan Programs. In addition, I am not in default on a loan made through a state conditional loan program;
 - F. I agree to notify the Office of Student Financial Aid immediately of any change in my address or in my financial status;
 - G. I understand that this grant is awarded to assist in meeting educational expenses and should I withdraw from classes, repayment of all or part of the grant may be required;
 - H. I understand that when I am able, I can voluntarily make financial contributions to the Higher Education Coordinating Board in recognition of this STATE NEED GRANT, and that these gifts will be used to provide financial assistance to other students;
 - I. I understand that the offer of a STATE NEED GRANT is subject to and conditioned upon the availability of funds. Further, I agree that the Higher Education Coordinating Board and the University of Washington reserve the right to withdraw, reduce, or modify the grant due to funding limitations or due to changes in circumstances which affect my eligibility for the STATE NEED GRANT;
 - J. I understand that STATE NEED GRANT awards are limited to a maximum of 15 full-time quarters of eligibility and that students may only receive STATE NEED GRANT at the University of Washington if they are pursuing their first bachelor's degree and are within 125% of the standard length of the program.
