### Duties and Responsibilities

Under direct supervision, organize and perform work related to overall clinic operations. This position works closely with staff and providers in ensuring our forms, educational materials, and patient packets are updated and maintained. Also included are simple computer inquiries in our scheduling system, such as checking upcoming appointments for insurance information and scheduled interpreters, as well as printing and mailing out appointment slips, and patient reminder calls. There will be general duties such as photocopying, faxing, filing, distributing mail and stocking supplies.
