Duties and Responsibilities

PRIMARY DUTIES: Be a part of a social work team by transporting and supervising visitation for children who are placed in out of home care due to abuse or neglect. Accurately document your observations of the parent-child interaction for inclusion into the official case file.

SECONDARY DUTIES: Assist social work staff in filing, copying, record organization, etc.

Minimum Qualifications

Student must be able to work a minimum of 3 hours in any given day. Must have the ability to interact with a variety of different personality types. A valid driver's license and proof of auto insurance are needed. NOTE: A criminal background check is required.

Educational Benefits

Learn how Child Protective Services, Child and Family Welfare Services and Family Reconciliation Services try to help families and when and how they decide to involve the Juvenile Court. Learn about community resources available to families. Learn first hand about drug abuse, mental illness, developmental disabilities, and other factors that impact families.
