Duties and Responsibilities

The Moens lab studies the early development of the nervous system using the zebrafish as a genetic model system. We are seeking work study students for the following jobs: 1) preparing laboratory reagents (solutions, bacterial plates, other tools and reagents for molecular biology and zebrafish genetics); 2) maintaining the aquatic facility (feeding fish, cleaning tanks, maintaining water quality); 3) helping with crossing and PCR-based genotyping of zebra fish stocks.

Minimum Qualifications

Applicants should be majoring in any area of science. No prior laboratory experience is required outside of lab classes. Careful attention to detail, a willingness to take direction and reliability are absolutely essential attributes for these positions.
