Duties and Responsibilities

Job Description: Provide spatial data support to various ecological economics projects, including some or all of the following tasks:

- Download and collate new datasets as necessary (e.g., Puget Sound LIDAR, high resolution temporal data for rainfall, runoff, and stream flow)
- Digitize location of key natural resources for industrial full cost accounting projects (e.g., coal life cycle analysis)
- Coordinate and communicate with project partners as necessary
- Some work may be completed remotely

Minimum Qualifications

- Work-study award or willingness to volunteer with time commitment of 2-10 hrs/wk;
- Coursework in Geographic Information Systems (GIS) using ArcGIS version 10.x or equivalent; additional coursework in remote sensing or past internship/independent study experience in GIS highly desirable.
- Self-motivation and ability to work independently; Interest in learning how a non-governmental organization (NGO) works.
- Candidate should possess an interest in the intersection between environmental
