Committee Membership

Committee Purpose

The UWCFD Events Committee was established to help promote and enhance the Washington State CFD efforts at the University of Washington. The purpose of the UWCFD Events Committee is to:

- Build a culture of giving by creating awareness of, and enthusiasm for, the CFD among UW faculty, staff, and charity representatives through events
- Increase campaign participation
- Increase contributions to CFD charities

Committee Responsibilities

Active participation will ensure that events are successfully implemented. The time commitment will vary each month, but is estimated at approximately 3 hours per month. Committee members are responsible for:

 - New Employee Coffee Hours
 - “Meet the Charities” workshops
- Attending Events Committee meetings
- Considering a personal contribution to their favorite charities via the UWCFD
- Publicly representing the UWCFD
