Earthquake Safety Fastening Guide

Books and items on shelves:
Install GripStrips™, shelf straps or nets to slow or prevent books and other items from falling.

Cabinets:
Install locking latches to keep items from spilling on to floor.

Tall Furniture:
Secure to wall studs with flexible steel brackets or adjustable furniture straps.

Shelf Edge Protectors:
Prevent client files from slipping out and spilling on to the floor.

Shelf Support:
Mini brackets keep adjustable shelves from sliding out.

Tall furniture placed next to partition walls:
Keep tall furniture from tipping over by restraining it with special partition brackets that do not need to be drilled to wall studs.

Computer Monitors:
Secure to desk with straps and QuakeMats™ to prevent damage and injury.

Framed Pictures & Mirrors:
Use special wire-trap hangers, heavy duty hooks, and / or earthquake strength Velcro® circles to prevent them from jumping off wall hooks.

Fire Extinguishers:
Strapping them to the wall keeps them from jumping off the mounting bracket, causing damage.

Computer Accessories & Electronic Equipment:
Keep items such as scanners, external drives, fax machines, phones, stereos in place with QuakeMats™ and/or fastening straps.

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Large appliances and office machines:
These items can potentially block paths for evacuation. Keep them from moving around or tipping by strapping them down to the floor or wall.
