NOTES 1. Provost Distribution amounts displayed may be less than the original Provost distribution, unspent funds are returned to the Provost budget when awardees receive external funding. 2. The Nov, 2015 and the May, 2016 cycles have a higher ROI than average. This is due to multiple factors: over those two years the percentage of awardees receiving external funding increased to 75% and they included high dollar grants - the two largest grants were \$15,915,986 (Nov 2015) and \$17,875,215 (May 2016) and is reflected in the ROI.
